#### ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

Must be received by **Friday**, **October 16<sup>th</sup> at 5 PM**. If you mail the certificate, it must be received by Friday at 5 PM. Please submit this as early as possible. If needed it can be amended up until Tuesday, October 20<sup>th</sup>. **LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT OHSAA APPROVAL** 

#### ON-LINE ENTRY

On-line entry will be used for this year's meet. Please follow the enclosed instructions to enter your participants. Deadline for on-line entry is Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup> at 11AM. Please submit your team entry as early as possible. You can make changes to your line-up anytime before the deadline, and if needed, on October 24<sup>th</sup>. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT OHSAA APPROVAL

#### CHECK IN ON RACE DAY

Coaches can pick up their team packet containing race information, box assignments, substitution forms, etc. in the P.E. building office.

#### SUBSTITUTIONS AND SCRATCHES

Substitution Forms will be provided in the coaches' packet. Any changes MUST be turned in at the Physical Education Office at least (1) hour before the scheduled start of your race. NO SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE PERMITTED AFTER THIS DEADLINE

# QUALIFIERS TO REGIONAL

Div. I Boys/Girls, Div. II Boys/Girls: The first FOUR (4) TEAMS PLUS any individual finishing in the top 16 places will qualify to the REGIONAL meet at TIFFIN.

# COURSE DESCRIPTION

LCCC provides a 5K (3.1 mile) course that has been accurately measured and the distance certified. A course map is enclosed.

# COURSE INSPECTION

Participating teams and individuals may inspect the course during the week prior to the district meet. Due to classes being conducted on campus, please do not allow your athletes to enter any buildings. On Saturday, October 24<sup>th</sup>, the course may be inspected from 10:30 AM to 12:55 PM., and between races. The course must be cleared 5 minutes prior to each race, and remain clear until the last runner has passed. Failure to comply with this regulation could result in disqualification of contestants.

# SCHOOL REPRESENTATIVE

No team or individual will be allowed to compete in the District Tournament unless a coach or person authorized by the Board of Education is present throughout the Tournament. Team and individual entries unaccompanied by such a school representative will be disgualified.

# COMMUNICATION DEVICES

No wireless communication devices may be used during the meet.

# UNIFORM NUMBERS

All competitors are required to wear a school uniform with the meet number assigned to the athlete attached to the FRONT of each runner's jersey.

# SPECTATORS/RESTRICTED AREAS/RECREATION EQUIPMENT/PETS

More than 80% of the course is visible from the central plateau. We will restrict access to the hill to **coaches only** during the race. Also, please remind parents and athletes to stay behind cones/tape/ropes in the finishing straight and chute areas. Also, please inform your athletes and parents that the use of **recreation equipment** (footballs, Frisbees, etc.) is **not permitted** under **OHSAA** regulation. This regulation also includes bringing **pets** to the meet.

# OTHER INFORMATION

**Spikes** - Most athletes are wearing one-half inch spikes. **Locker rooms** - We advise dressing at home. There is limited locker room space. Scoring - We will be using the COMPUTOSCORE program for scoring.
Awards - Team trophy awarded to champion and runner-up teams. No individual awards.
Results - Results will be posted on the windows outside the P.E. office and outside near the T-shirt tent (weather permitting) within 30 minutes after each race is completed.
Coaches can pick up a set of results in the P.E. office after they become official.
Parking - Parking for cars and busses will be in the lots northeast of the P.E. building.
Additional car parking will be available in the lot west of the P.E. building.
Hospitality room - Room 102 will be used as a hospitality room for coaches and the media following the conclusion of the officials' meeting at 12:15 PM.
T-shirts - District T-shirts will be on sale near the tennis courts (weather permitting), or in the lobby of the P.E. building from 11AM to 4 PM.
