Awards:

In the girls and boys varsity races, trophies will be awarded to the top 3 teams in the White, Green, and Black races. Medals will be presented to the 1st thru 20th place finishers and ribbons will be presented to the 21st thru 40th place finishers. Fourth thru twentieth place finishers will receive their medals in the chute area. First thru third place finishers will have the medals presented to them on the podium during the awards presentation at the conclusion of the race day. In the boys and girls high school reserve races, medals will be presented to the 1st thru 10th place finishers and ribbons will be presented to 11th thru 40th place finishers. All medals and ribbons for the reserve races will be presented in the chute. In the junior high races, plaques will be awarded to the top 3 teams in both the girls and boys races. Medals will be presented to the 1st thru 20th place finishers and ribbons will be awarded to the 21st thru 40th place finishers. First thru third place finishers will receive their medals on the podium during the awards presentation at the conclusion of the race day. All other medals will be presented in the chute. The MARK PITZER MEMORIAL AWARD will be presented to the high school male runner with the fastest time of the day. The JOHN SUBA AWARD will be presented to the fastest female runner of the day. Coaches, please make every effort to stay for the awards presentations if your kids are involved. This day is for the student/athletes who put forth tremendous effort each and every day in the classroom and during competition. Climbing a podium is something they will never forget! Thanks!

Scoring:

Scoring will follow the Track and Field Rule 9-2 for cross country.

Entry:

Entry fees are as follows:

Varsity Boys and Girls - \$80.00 for each varsity team.

Reserve Boys and Girls - \$45.00 for each reserve team.

Junior High Boys and Girls - \$45.00 for each JH team.

Individual: Varsity \$25.00 per runner and Reserve / JH \$15.00 per runner.

\$210.00 maximum per school for events.

***Entry fees due race day!**

- Each school may enter a maximum of **10** runners per varsity race. Runners must be listed on the State Eligibility sheet.
- Races will be started promptly on the half hour.
- Coaches should instruct their athletes to remove their chip before exiting the chute area.

Miscellaneous:

A fully stocked 20 x 40 foot concession stand will be available. T-shirts will be sold near the concession area. Thank you for your attendance this year! This event is truly driven by the participating schools and their following. We appreciate you!

I hope this letter finds you and your team filled with enthusiasm for the upcoming season. We, at the Greenville Athletic Department, are very excited about the upcoming Greenville-Treaty City Cross Country Invitational. This invitational is one of the largest in the State of Ohio. This year we are looking at hosting close to 3,000 runners. It promises to be an outstanding event.

To accommodate our growth, there are several things I need you to be aware of before you arrive on August 30, 2014.

- * Byron Kimmel from Alliance Running has been contracted to time and score the meet for 2014. All of your entries must be done on the Alliance Running web site prior to your arrival. Go to www.baumspage.com to complete roster entry and race entry. This must be done before the deadlines posted on the web site. If you have problems with the site, you can contact Byron at 937-506-8361.
- * **In order to alleviate congestion in the park, there will be no bus parking in the park this year. Please have your bus driver proceed up Memorial Drive to drop the team off at the race site. Once the team is dropped off, the driver should follow the enclosed map to park at Greenville High School.**
- * **Teams are responsible for getting back to their busses after the event. There will be no busses permitted to pickup their teams after the races.**
- * Please arrive in time to have your team checked in and situated. All coaches **must** come to the check in table located directly outside of the Masonic Temple.
- * We will have complete medical coverage for our event. Thanks to the cooperation of our area rescue squads, our athletic trainer, and the physicians at Family Health, we will be able to handle almost all medical events at the race site.
- * Please note that there will be expanded concession and restroom facilities on site at the Masonic Temple. Also, we will be again selling commemorative t-shirts from the race.
