The 2012 Legends



Marc Hunter - A 1974 graduate of Brunswick HS and a 1979 graduate of Cleveland State University, Marc was the 1973 and 1974 Ohio High School DI State Mile Champion, 1973 DI State Champion in Cross Country, 1972 State Runner up in Cross Country. Marc was the 1st American finisher (4th overall) in the 1977 NCAA Division I Collegiate Cross Country Championships. He was a two time Division I Collegiate Cross Country All-American. Marc qualified for the 1980 Olympic Trials in the 5000m run and the 10,000m run. He competed in the 5k in the 1980 Olympic Trials. He earned All-American in Indoor Track Honors in 1978 (3 mile run) and was a member of three US teams: Cross Country World Championship Team in 1978 & 1979 and the Pan-Pacific US Track Team in 1980. In 1978 Marc was the 17th ranked cross country runner in the world. Marc is the current All-Ohio Collegiate Record Holder in the 5000m run (outdoors), 2 mile run (outdoors) and the 3 mile run (indoors) as well as the current holder of the Collegiate All Ohio Meet course record at Ohio Wesleyan set in 1977. He holds the 1500m, 5k, 10k records at Cleveland State and was a member of the US Record setting 4xMile Relay team run in New Zealand in 1981 competing for Athletics West. Marc was one of 10 athletes selected for the

original Athletics West Olympic Development Team in 1980. Marc holds High School PRs - 440: 49.8, 880: 1:56, Mile 4:14, 2 mile 9:36 College PRs - 800: 1:52, 1500: 3:45, Mile 4:01, 2 mile: 8:38, 5,000: 13:36, 10,000: 28:40.



Jenny Morgan - Competed for Barnesville and Clarkston (MI) High Schools and University of Michigan. She was a nine time individual state champion in high school and twice a member of state champion 4x 800m relay teams. She won the state championship 1600 meter run all four years of high school and the 3200 meter run three times. As a sophomore, she set Division II Ohio State Meet records for both the 1600 meter (4:53.87) and the 3200 meter runs (10:49.44). Jenny was a member of two national championship 4xmile teams, the 2003 Penn Relays runner-up and was a two time 3200 meter All-American.

At Michigan, Jenny was a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection (2008-10) ... Three-time U-M Athletic Academic Achievement Award winner (2008-10).

Jenny is currently in medical school at the University of Michigan.



Harrison Dillard - Harrison Dillard is the only man to ever win Olympic gold medals in both the sprints and high hurdles. Overall, he won four Olympic gold medals, also taking two in the 4x100 relays in 1948 and 1952. Dillard attended Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio, where he won four national collegiate titles in the high and low hurdles. He also took 14 AAU outdoor titles in the high and low hurdles and lost the opportunity for more because of the outbreak of World War II. After winning 82-straight hurdles races, Dillard failed to make the 1948 London Olympic team as a hurdler but qualified in the 100 meters where he out leaped the favored Barney Ewell of the U.S. to win the gold medal. Four years later, he won the gold medal in the 110m hurdles. A world record holder in both the high and low hurdles, Dillard won the 1953 Sullivan Award as the nation's top amateur athlete.



Bernice Robinson Holland - A hurdler in the 1948 Olympic Games, Bernice won the Olympic Trials in the 80 meter hurdles and was runner-up in the high jump. Bernice was the American Record holder for the 80 meter hurdles and also held the indoor American Record for the high jump. She has recently distinguished herself as an international competitor in the Master Program. In the Masters Pan American Games in Canada she won and set records in the Shot Put, Discus and Javelin. In 1983 she placed 2nd in the Shot Put and Discus and 4th in the Javelin in the World Masters Games and then again as recently as 1985, in the

55 to 60 years age group, placed 4th, 4th, 6th respectively in those same events. Bernice is a 1986 Cleveland Sports Hall of Fame Inductee.

The 2012 Legends Cross Country Meet Information

Date and Location

Saturday, October 6th, 2012. The meet will be held at the Trumbull County Fairgrounds (4181 Hoagland Blackstub Rd. Cortland, OH). The Fairgrounds offer an excellent facility for cross country meets. Ample parking, sheltered seating and restrooms are available to complement a fast, spectator-friendly course. Maplewood HS will be the host school for The Legends Meet.

Awards

The top three teams in the high school races and the top two teams in the middle school races will receive team picture plaque awards. The top 7 members of the winning high school teams and the coach will receive individual awards. The top 25 individuals in the high school races and the top 15 individuals in the middle school races will receive individual awards. Individual champions in each race will receive picture plaques of them. Team awards and the award for individual champions for each race will be presented by "The Legends" in front of the grandstands 1 hour after the scheduled start time of each race. Individual awards are presented at the finish of each race.

Entry

Any school may enter the meet by:

1. Registration - completing the school registration form located [here](#) to reserve a position. Teams should complete the school registration form as soon as possible since we anticipate limiting the size of the fields in team races. Divisions will be decided by OHSAA assignments.
2. Entering Rosters on Baum's Page next fall.

Fees

- \$75 HS Boys (unlimited entries; \$10 per individual if less than 7 runners)
- \$75 HS Girls (unlimited entries; \$10 per individual if less than 7 runners)
- \$50 MS Boys (unlimited entries; \$10 per individual if less than 5 runners)
- \$50 MS Girls (unlimited entries; \$10 per individual if less than 5 runners)

* A minimum of 5 runners and a maximum of 9 runners are permitted in the team races. Schools with more than 9 runners must enter the extras in the open race or enter a "B Team".

* You may enter an additional "B Team" to compete in the varsity race for an additional \$25 per extra squad. Extra teams will be permitted only as space allows in each varsity race.

* Each coach submitting a full squad into any one of the four races will receive a coaches gift.

Team awards will be presented in front of the grandstands 1 hour after the scheduled start time of each race.

Points of Interest

We will be using the IPICO Chip Timing System - a chip that is attached to the runner's shoe. There will be a bullpen area at the finish of the race where water will be available and chips will be collected. If coaches have runners that do not run or do not finish the race, they must turn in the numbers for those athletes at the registration area. Schools will be charged \$10 each for missing chip. Runners will also wear a bib number on the front of their singlet that matches their chip number.

Coaches are asked to please cooperate in advance by:

- Completing the online team registration form at <http://www.gopherarun.com/legendsmeet/register/>
- Submitting rosters online at baumspage.com by at least one week prior to the meet.
- Ensuring correct numbers are pinned properly on the front of each runner
- Ensuring chips corresponding to issued bib numbers are placed on runners shoes... and all chips returned after race.
- Times will be available at the 1 and 2 mile marks for each race.
- Concessions and other vendors will be available beneath the grandstands.
- Results will be available at www.gopherarun.com
- Meet T-shirts will be sold at the registration area.
- Restrooms are available under the grandstands and in adjacent buildings.
