Team awards will be presented to the top three schools in the high school races and the top three in the middle school races. We will also have individual awards for the top 25 varsity runners and top 25 middle school runners.

RACE GUIDELINES

- ➤ The enrollment cutoff between the Large and Small School Divisions (255 boys or girls) is approximately the midpoint in the OHSAA enrollment range for Division II.
- > Schools that would normally enter the Small School Division may enter the Large School Division if they choose to do so.
- > Schools may enter a maximum of seven runners in the high school races. There is no limit on the number of entries in the middle school races.
- > There is no need to designate which students will run in which race.
- > Schools with less than five runners may enter the high school race. Those entries will be displaced for scoring purposes.
- Schools may enter two teams in the high school races but will be charged an additional entry fee.
- ➤ Buses are to drop off athletes on Woody Hayes Drive at the entrance to the stadium. They are then to park in the lots behind West Elementary or behind Newcomerstown Middle School. South Beaver Street (the front side of the high school) will be closed to all vehicles except for residents of the street. We have had too many problems with illegal parking and people parking in yards of the houses on that street so we are closing it.
