<u>Piketon Cross Country Invitational</u> Coaches Information

Welcome to the 2011 Piketon Cross Country Invitational. We hope you and your athletes will have a positive experience today. Please read the following information carefully as we hope to make things go as efficiently as possible.

Enclosed in your packet will be the following.....two course maps for jr high and high school, your roster with your athletes and their assigned numbers (tags), starting box assignments, top 25 times list, best times by school on this course and a trash bag.

If you have not already paid your entry fee, please leave it with meet personnel at the table near the finish line.

You may set up tens anywhere except on the course or soccer field. *Please use the trash bag that is provided in your packet and clean up any trash that might be in your camp area. Thanks!*

Restrooms are available at the concession stand and there are portajohns as well. There are also restrooms available in the school building but please announce to your athletes to avoid wearing spikes indoors. This has been a problem in the past.

Awards:

Jr. High – two team trophies, three individual trophies, 4th-40th medals, 41st-75th ribbons High School – three team trophies, three individual trophies, 4th-50th medals, 51st-100th ribbons

It is essential that your athletes report to the start at least 10 minutes before their scheduled race.

Please have your athletes dropped off behind the high school near the starting line and then return to the front of the school building to park your bus. If the front lot gets full, please have them use the parking lot on the east side of the high school building (in the direction of the old high school).

We are using Hy Tek to score the meet. Please match the numbers on the ribbons with the athlete on your roster list that is enclosed in the packet. Pin the numbers in the black circle, not the hole. WE will be tearing them off at the endo of the chute and using it to score the meet. All individual awards will be passed out at the end of the chute. We will also pass out index cards at the end of the chute but you will not need to return them unless we have a computer problem and ask you to do so. Results should be completed within about 20 minutes after the conclusion of each race unless we have unexpected problems.

The course is the same as it has been for the past seven years. High school races follow white arrows, junior high races follow pink arrows.

Results will be posted on a table near the finish line ASAP – you may also get them from baumspage just a few hours after the race.
