Ticket Information

There will be NO cash sales at the entrance(s). All tickets must be purchased online. Presale Tickets = \$10.00 Gameday Tickets = \$12.00

Presale tickets will go on sale five (5) days prior to the event taking place (when opponents are known; it may be a smaller window if opponents are not yet identified). Please ask your fans to be patient and only reach out to inquire about events showing on the site if you are not seeing it posted within 48 hours of the start time.

- o There will also be a game-day ticket available (\$2.00 more than a presale ticket) for the sectional through regional levels available three hours prior to the start of the event and until capacity has been reached or until the event has reached its halfway point. With this, tickets CAN be purchased at the gate, they would simply have to purchase digitally on their smart device.
- o All ticketing will be available for purchase at www.ohsaa.org/tickets.

Parking Information

Parking is not permitted inside Hedges-Boyer Park. Parking is found outside of the park.

General Information

Hedges-Boyer Park provides a 5K (3.1 mile) course that has been accurately measured. The start and finish are located in the upper oval and the course is well marked. Most athletes have been wearing ½" to 3/8" spikes, depending on weather.

Registration and packet pick-up will be conducted at the large grey barn located near the swimming area and beyond the basketball courts. Bus parking is accessed through the Coe Street entrance.

To have a successful meet, we are asking you to provide your athletes with the following information:

- 1. Contestant Materials & Verification Form: To obtain your packet, you must present a signed copy of the OHSAA Cross Country Coach's Verification Form (download from Baumspage.com, print & sign). Packets will not be distributed before the morning of the meet but all forms and information will be available at Baumspage.com.
- 2. Results: Preliminary & Unofficial Results will be posted to www.baumspage.com immediately after each race. Coaches will have 30 minutes after release of the results to file an appeal with the Referee. Official results will be read over the loudspeaker after the appeals period is over and the Referee has certified the results.
- 3. Contestant Numbers: Contestant numbers and pins will be provided in your packet. Numbers must be worn on the FRONT of each contestant and securely fastened with four pins. Every athlete must run with the assigned number.
- 4. Contestant Chips: Chips will be provided in your packet. Chips must be securely fastened (double knotted) to EACH shoe on EACH athlete. Every athlete must run with his/her assigned chips (the number on the chip matches the contestant's bib number.) Chips should be returned by the coach to Chip Tent next to registration before leaving the property.

- 5. COACHES' RESPONSIBILITY: IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH HEAD COACH TO ENSURE THAT EACH ATHLETE WEARS THE ASSIGNED BIB NUMBER AND CHIP.
- 6. NON-RETURNED CHIPS: Coaches are responsible for all chips not returned by the end of the meet. Schools will be billed \$25 for each chip not returned.
- 7. Awards: All awards will be distributed by the OHSAA.
- 8. Uniforms: Please review with your athletes the OHSAA Uniform Regulation Checklist (available at Baumspage.com) and all current uniform rules. Athletes who compete in an illegal uniform are in violation of these rules and are subject to disqualification. It is the responsibility of the athletes and coach to have each competitor dressed properly according to rule before competition begins. The start of a race will not be delayed to permit an athlete to change into a legal uniform. All final decisions about uniforms rest with the Tournament Referee.
- 9. TO MAKE A SUBSTITUTION TO YOUR TEAM LINE-UP (District to Regional): Prior to the Meet: E-mail your change to Mike Chatfield at mike@finishtiming.com. Please include TIFFIN REGIONAL, DIVISION, GENDER, NAME, and SCHOOL of the athlete to be replaced with the name and grade of the replacement athlete. Day of the Meet: See Dennis Baum at Registration for a Substitution Form. Forms are also available at Baumspage.com. You cannot substitute for an individual gualifier to the Regional Tournament.
- 10. IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO RE-ENTER YOUR TEAM OR INDIVIDUAL ON BAUMSPAGE.
- 11. IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO RESUBMIT AN OHSAA TEAM ROSTER.
