Hello Coaches and Athletic Directors!

This year Seneca East will be hosting its 10<sup>th</sup> annual cross country invitational! The course runs on the grounds of the school complex and adjoining woods. On the day of the race, the course will be clearly marked and painted as if it's a highway. Attached are course maps for both the junior high and high school courses. The maps also list areas of interest including bus and spectator parking, team camps, restrooms, concessions, and awards. This year the races will be run exactly as last year, as we have split teams into three separate divisions for high school and three separate junior high divisions, allowing ample award opportunities for your athletes! We have assigned divisions taking into consideration enrollment figures (not exactly Division I, II, & III). Races are labeled as “White Division” being the smaller schools, “Orange Division” being medium sized schools, and “Black Division” being larger schools. Junior high teams are also assigned to the same division as their respective high school teams or the respective high school teams that their middle schools feed into. Schools sending only a junior high team are noted in the team list below. All races will be unlimited entries for each team, there will be no open races! This will allow teams the opportunity to run everyone the first weekend of the season and assist teams in determining varsity rosters for the weeks to come. We will be using electronic chip timing once again this year! **BE SURE TO RUN THE RACE YOU HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED** or else issues may occur with the timing system. If you have any questions regarding your race assignment please contact the meet manager (contact info located at bottom of meet info). Please ensure you turn in all used and unused chips at the finish line! Any chip not turned in will result in a \$25.00 fee sent to your school athletic director. We truly hope you enjoy your day at Seneca East! Any feedback is more than welcome, and will be reviewed for future meets as our ultimate goal is to put on a first-class event for everyone!

### **Packets**

Please pick up your packets near the start and finish line when you arrive at the meet. As usual, we will be attempting to greet your team bus with your packets as you arrive.

### **Inclement Weather**

In the event of inclement weather, please move all athletes to school buses. Coaches should report to the school office (front entrance of school) to meet and find out more information. Please keep phones handy, as email communication will be used throughout the day in the event of a weather delay.

### **Chip Timing**

In each packet there will be a bib number and chip for each runner submitted. All athletes must return their chip to the chip bucket after finishing their race before exiting the chute area. Coaches, please return any unused chip to the bucket as well. A fee of \$25 will be charged for each chip not returned.

### **Starting Boxes**

Starting boxes will be assigned to comply with OHSA regulations. Starting box numbers will be printed on the front of your team packets.

### **T-shirts & Concessions**

T-shirts will be available near the concession stand area at a cost of \$15.00. There will be a variety of food and drink available, as well as Kona Ice items available for purchase throughout the day!

### **Team Drop-off/Pickup Information**

Buses will be directed to unload athletes near the concessions and awards area, and then proceed to park in designated bus parking area. **Once again this year, WHITE DIVISION buses are NOT permitted to drive to the front of the school to pick coaches and athletes up. Please have your teams walk to the bus parking lot to load the buses!**

### **Spectator Parking**

As noted above, there is a \$5.00 charge per person, or a \$10.00 maximum per vehicle to attend the invitational to help encourage carpooling. There is one entrance into the school campus. All spectators will be directed to enter the complex and then directed to park in the available lots. Parking has went extremely well the past few years, but there is always a chance of a delay. Coaches, please inform your spectators to arrive with extra time as backups are a possibility.
