****School will be in session when you arrive on Friday**** Athletes will be asked to stay in one of our two gymnasiums until school is out

Check in: 1:30pm - 2:00 pm

Head Coach – Please report to check in tables located inside the back entrance to school on the 1st floor to sign O.H.S.A.A. paperwork. Upon sign in you will receive a tournament packet with the following items.

- Brackets and team information. (check/correct all information)
- 1 pass per qualifier (NO extra passes for alternates, stats, etc.)
- Team Passes (coaches, stats, trainer, bus driver) will be given as follows:
 - 1 to 2 Qualifiers (3 Passes)
 - 3 to 4 Qualifiers (4 Passes)
 - 5 to 6 Qualifiers (5 Passes)
 - 7 to 8 Qualifiers (6 Passes)
 - 9 or More Qualifiers (8 Passes)

Team personnel passes needed for admittance, bullpen entrance & to sit mat side.

Passes will allow admittance to tournament both days. Do not Lose!

There will be no replacements.

Weigh-in: 2:00pm

All wrestlers shall be present and will be called to the designated weigh-in area over the PA. Please make sure to listen for your weight class and report promptly.

All wrestlers should be ready to weigh in at 2:00pm

- A. All OHSAA Skin Authorizations appropriately signed and dated must be presented at weigh-in
- B. The weigh-in shall proceed through weight classes beginning at 106 lbs. and end immediately upon completion of the 285 lb. class. A contestant may step on and off the first scale two times. If he fails to make weight on the first scale, he shall immediately step on alternate scale one time.

Concessions:

Food tables will not be permitted in the gymnasium, a full concession stand is made available to wrestlers and spectators. **No electric available-Please clean up!**

Locker rooms, Coolers:

Locker rooms will be assigned by sectional sites. As usual, we expect a sellout crowd for all sessions. Buckeye Local High School will NOT be responsible for any items lost or damaged. No coolers are permitted in the gymnasium!

Hospitality Room:

Hospitality Room is for coaches, officials and tournament staff only. Do not abuse the benefits of a hospitality room by inviting friends, family, and children. Please do not take advantage of our volunteers who go out of their way to provide hospitality for all coaches, officials, and staff. Individual Awards:

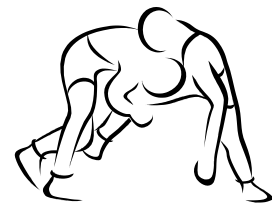
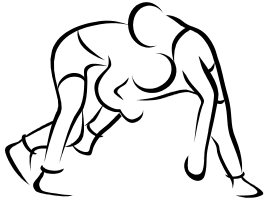

After the 138 pound matches and before the 145 pound matches we will recognize 106 thru 132 pound top 5 finalists. After the 182 pound matches and before the 195 pound matches we will recognize 138 thru 170 pound top 5 finalists. After the 285 pound matches we will recognize 182 thru 285 pound top 5 finalists.
