Spectator Cart Rules

The Ohio High School Athletic Association and Southwest District Athletic Board establish the rules and procedures for high school golf, including (for the first time) permitting spectators to rent carts this year. Please comply with the following rules!

- Carts must stay on the cart path. If you need to be away from the cart path, you should leave your cart on the path and walk.
- Please be cognizant of all the players in the group you are watching and also those on nearby holes. Move your cart only when nearby players will not be distracted.
- Spectator carts may not be used to transport players or their equipment unless there is a weather or medical emergency. A player can be disqualified for riding in a spectator cart.
- Electronic communication devices (cell phones, etc.) must be turned off or silenced. If you need to use yours, you should get out of your cart and walk to a location that is totally away from all golfers.

District spectators at both Glenview and Beavercreek must be older than 21 years, have to agree to follow the above rules, and need to pay the golf course \$15 each for use of the golf cart.

Carts can not be reserved ahead of time.
All carts will likely be rented out.
Carts will be available on a first come,
first serve basis. When the carts are all
gone, that will be it for carts for the day.
