Green Fees: Participating schools will not be charged green fees for competition rounds of play. Fees will be paid by NWDAB/OHSAA; includes - range balls, coach's cart, and light lunch.

Practice rounds: Cost for each player is \$15 per round. Call the course for tee-times and additional information. Range balls are not provided for practice rounds.

Practice facility: Located at 2986 E. Catawba Rd., includes a practice range and putting green. It is best for competitors to drive directly to the practice facility prior to golf. A putting green will also be available near the clubhouse.

Tee-times: The first groups will tee off on numbers 1 and 10 at 10:00am sharp!

Shuttles: Available between certain holes for <u>players only</u>. **Playoff holes**: If needed, beginning at hole #17, then #18.

Tournament results: Team and individual results will be posted on BaumsPage.

Admission: Tickets may be purchased in advance online for \$8. \$10 at the course also online.

Spectator carts: May be available on a limited basis. \$25 per cart.

State Qualifiers: Two (2) teams and two (2) individuals not on a qualifying team will advance to the state tournament. The Division II Boys State Golf Tournament will at the North Star Golf Club Friday and Saturday, October 15 and 16. Please read all information carefully. If you have any questions, please contact Ken Baumgartner, Manager.

Reminders:

- 1) Tobacco rule applies to all players and coaches. Tobacco is prohibited in the clubhouse, on the driving range and on the course.
- 2) Scorecards will be exchanged at the starting holes and must be turned in at the end of the round with TWO signatures.
- 3) Remind players that no conversation can occur with spectators while playing.
- 4) Players should report to the scoring area immediately after the completion of their round.
- 5) Limited spectator carts will be available for \$25.
- 6) Admission for spectators is \$8 per person, purcassed online in advance \$8.00. Ticket codes will be sent to participating athletic directors. Tickets may be available at the site for \$10.
- 7) All players will report unofficial 9-hole scores at the turn. Those partial results will be posted on BaumsPage.
- 8) **Playoff(Ties):** Ties will be resolved by rule, for qualifying positions, both team and individual. Playoff holes are #17, then #18, repeated as needed.

Rules for Spectators

From the OHSAA Handbook

2021-22 OHSAA GOLF REGULATIONS

Rule 6: 6.3) Spectators

Spectators are permitted, but are NOT permitted to converse with participants. It will be the responsibility of contestants in each threesome to caution ANY spectator from talking to or interfering with contestants in their group. Failure to do so may result in a penalty or disqualification of contestants involved.

From the USGA, OHSAA and NWDAB, spectators:

- May use carts if available at the course. Carts must stay on cart paths! NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Are permitted to WALK on the course. Spectator carts are permitted. Contact tournament management, in advance of the tournament, if ADA disability carts are needed.
- Must stay OFF fairways.
- Turn OFF cell phones. People using cell phones will receive one warning; second time phone will be taken!
- Spectators should stay 20-50 yards from players at all times, should be in front or behind players.
- May help search for golf balls.
- Must have NO conversation with players. They may applaud and/or say good putt or hit.
- Must stay at least 20 yards from green and tees.
