

Welcome to PipeStone Golf Club Division II Girls District Tournament

Format for Today

Today's format is an 18-hole individual stroke play event with four scores of the five counting towards qualifying for the State Tournament. OHSAA, USGA, and PipeStone local rules will govern play today. Pace of play is very important, please make sure that each group plays at a pace of fifteen minutes per hole or 4 ½ hours for eighteen. Please make sure to rotate scorecards within your group and verify hole-by-hole scores after completion of play. Make sure each scorecard has two signatures and that each participant has an identifying mark on their golf ball.

Rules of the Day

- 1. The participants will play from the Green Tees.
- 2. All Play will be governed by the OHSAA and USGA rules of golf.
- 3. Out of Bounds is defined by White Stakes or Lines on #7, #8, #10 #13, #14, #15, #16 and #17.
- 4. Lateral Hazards are defined by Red Stakes or Lines on #2, #12, #13, #15, #16, #17 & #18
- 5. Yellow Stakes or Lines define water Hazards #3, #4, #5, #6, #7, #10, #11, #13, #16, #17 & #18.
- 6. Ground Under Repair is defined by White.
- 7. Natural areas with high grass will be played as a lateral hazard!
- 8. Play will begin off #1 & #10, please spend no more than five minutes on the turn and proceed to your back nine.. .
- 9. The Scoring area will be located outside on the patio, if inclement weather the boards will be located in the clubhouse.
- 10. If you are in doubt as to procedure or a rules situation, announce your intentions to play a second ball and which ball will count if the rules permit. Complete the hole with two balls. The competitor MUST report the facts of the situation to the Committee before returning the scorecard. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 11. The OHSAA coaching rule is in effect.
- 12. The OHSAA electronics rule is in effect.
- 13. Spectators may not talk to the players. They may, however, point out golf balls. A player will be disqualified for riding in a cart. Players may not have anyone caddy for them or pull a cart for them.
- 14. Any tobacco use by participants will result in disqualification.
- 15. **TWO STROKE PENALTY** for conduct unbecoming high school players. Such conduct shall include, but not be limited to: club throwing (releasing the club in a manner that could cause harm to any person on the course or damage the course), use of abusive language and willful acts to damage property or equipment on the course. Conduct deemed severe by the rules committee could result in disqualification.
- 16. Only the school coach may have a cart. By OHSAA rule there will be no carts for spectators.

Qualifying—3 teams and 3 individuals not on a qualifying team.

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of play! Playoffs will only be held for the final qualifying spots.
