Tournament Information:

Please check in at the registration table to confirm your lineup upon arrival at the golf course.

USGA rules will govern play.

Play will be from the red tees.

Local rules:

All uncut areas beyond the mown rough (natural grass/heather) will be played as a lateral hazard. Rules for lateral hazards will apply including moving loose impediments and grounding your club.

**Note:**

*There are several instances where the natural grass/heather is in close proximity to a cart path. Please review with your players the procedure when taking relief from a hazard involves a cart path.*

*Drop areas will be in play on holes 2, 7, 9, 12, and 18. If a player chooses to use a drop area, the ball must be dropped and played within the drop area. A ball that is dropped and rolls outside of the drop area must be re-dropped.*

*Yardage posts in fairways: A shot that strikes a yardage post may be replayed from a spot nearest as possible to the spot from which the original shot was played without penalty.*

*Bunker Drains: Players ball or stance may be impeded by drains located in several bunkers throughout the golf course. In this event please players are eligible for a one club length drop no closer to the hole at no penalty.*

Coaches and players will be notified on the day of the tournament if there will be additional local rules.

All OHSAA rules will be in effect.

A rules committee consisting of PGA Professionals, Josh Boggs, Chuck Doran, Rob Bragg, and PGM intern Dennis Rysz, will make all final rules decisions.

There will be three rules officials available on the golf course to help with decisions during play. As always, if an official is not available, players should play an alternate ball and request a decision at the completion of play.

Players are requested to report to the first tee 10 minutes before their assigned tee time.

Upon completion of play, players are to immediately report to the scoring area. A rules official will go over the hole by hole score on each card prior to players signing their cards.

OHSAA tie breaker rules will be in effect in the event of a tie for the final team spot. A playoff will be held after all players have completed play in the event of a tie for the final individual spot.
