PLAYERS ARE TO REPORT TO THEIR STARTING TEE 10 MINUTES PRIOR TO THEIR TEE TIME. Players should introduce themselves and identify their golf ball.

Four rules officials will be on the course at all times. Coaches should call a rules official when needed.

The paper scorecard will be the official card. Each pairing will have 1 paper scorecard with all 3 players name printed on it. We will also use the live scoring on the OHSAA app. One player in the group will keep all 3 scores on the scorecard. The other 2 players must keep scores on the mobile app. Players will report to score table upon completion of round before attesting scorecards.

OHSAA has instituted a 12 shot maximum score for all championship tournaments. After the 12th shot players are to pick up there ball and record a 12.

USGA Rules are in effect. The one ball rule is not in effect.

Ball in natural (conservation) areas must be dropped outside the area and played as a penalty area. These areas are defined by knee high or higher grass and weeds.

Bunkers can be played "lift, rake, and place."

Woods on the perimeter of the golf course are to be played as a penalty area. Right side of holes #1, #2, #3 and #4.

Drop Circles will be marked on all water holes.

Pace of play – 45 seconds per shot. You must stay up with the group ahead and use no more than 15 minutes per hole.
