

Play is governed by the current USGA Rules of Golf, the OHSAA Golf Manual \& Golf Regulations and the Notice to Players, which applies to this golf course.

Format: 18-Hole, Individual Stroke Play
Tee Markers: Red Tee Markers, Holes \#3, 4, 11 - tees are located at start of fairway
Drop Zones: located on Holes \#4, 5, 9, 12, 13, 14

All wooded areas on the course will be played as a red penalty area.
All native/fescue grass is a red penalty area. These areas may not be marked by red stakes or lines. The margin of the penalty area is the start of the fescue grass.

12 is the MAXIMUM score you can record on any hole
Ties that affect the number of qualifiers shall be resolved by playing an additional hole or holes until the tie is broken. If a tie does not affect the number of qualifiers,
a. Team ties to determine order of play in the next tournament will be broken by: better 5th score, better 4th score, better 3rd score, better 2nd score, better 1st score, coin toss.
b. Individual ties will use the USGA Tiebreaker based on the Last 9, 6, 3, 1 holes played versus par. OHSAA tournaments will designate Holes 10 to 18 as the last holes regardless of the starting hole.
