Division III Sectional Qualifier – September 23rd, 2014

Coaches Information Sheet

- Play begins at off #1 tee and #10 (8:30am)
- Play will be from the Blue Tees (course length approx. 6400 – 6600 yards)
- Hole; #11 drop zone is the entire red tee box. Also there is another drop zone to the right of the 18th green for the heather behind the 18 green.
- All heather grass is considered a lateral hazard (heather grass is grass that has not been mowed down and is a height of around 1ft+). Make sure players understand **Rule 26** in **The Rules of Golf** for lateral hazards.
 - (Specimen Local Rule Water Hazard: Ball Played Provisionally Under Rule 26-1)
- The main holes for heather are holes
 - 1-10, 11,
 - 12 and 13 (left and behind the greens)
 - 14 and 15 (left by the green and behind the green)
 - 16
 - 17
 - 18 (left and right plus behind the green.)
- Internal Out of Bounds - Hole #10 while playing hole #9; Hole #9 while playing hole #8.
- Marshalls will be on the golf course and will be enforcing the Pace of Play Policy
- All rulings will be made by the Rules Committee only.
- USGA Rules will apply to all play.
- After your player has holed out on #18 he or she will proceed to the scorers table to sign their scorecards (Backroom of the clubhouse). There will be an area for coaches to speak to their player before they sign their card.
- Remember – the round is not complete until the scorecard is signed and handed in at the scorer table. In the backroom of the clubhouse.
- Range Finders are permitted provided these are not part of a communication device and meets rules and standards set by the USGA.
- The player's coach/designated is the only person who may assist the player and this may not be done on the green or in a hazard.
