

COVID-19 Coach & Player Protocols

1. Prior to departing for the golf course, it is each coach's responsibility to conduct COVID-19 symptom checks for his/her team. Any golfer and/or coach exhibiting symptoms should be sent home immediately and should not be transported to the golf course. Please complete the attached COVID-19 monitoring form and turn it in at the golf course. These forms will be requested by the county health department should contact tracing need to take place.
2. Facial coverings are required when on your transportation vehicle and should be worn throughout the day except when the players are warming up and competing. Coaches should wear facial coverings throughout the day when they are unable to maintain a distance of 6 feet.
3. In addition to bringing snacks and facial coverings, players are also encouraged to bring their own personal hand sanitizer.
4. Remind your players to practice "social distancing" as much as possible while they are at and on the golf course. Do not gather on the tee boxes or near the holes. We need to avoid large congregations of players and coaches.
5. Players and coaches should refrain from entering the clubhouse as much as possible. Restrooms will be available in the clubhouse and on the golf course. If clubhouse entry is necessary, facial coverings are required at all times.
6. Upon arrival, each team bus/van will be greeted in the parking lot. Coaches and players should not leave their team transportation vehicle until instructed to do so by a tournament official.
7. Coaches will be given a packet that contains tournament rules and scorecards. Please go over the rules with your individual team. We will **NOT** be having a coaches meeting or large group gathering to go over the rules.
8. When instructed to leave the vehicle, coaches can pick up their assigned cart outside of the pro shop. You will use the same cart throughout the day. Players can proceed directly to the driving range while continuing to wear their facial coverings. Each team will have an assigned warm up area on the driving range. One player at a time can warm up, please rotate players so that everyone gets a chance. While on the driving range and practice green, players should avoid contact with non-personal items such as range balls and practice cups.
9. Coaches, tournament officials and golf course personnel will transport players to their respective starting tee box. Upon arrival at the tee, players should tee off immediately. During the round, players should maintain social distancing, sanitize throughout the day and refrain from touching other player's equipment and golf balls.
10. Each player should keep score for all three players in their group using the scorecards that are provided. At the completion of the round, each group should verbally verify scores hole-by-hole. This verification should take place away from others. Once scores are agreed upon by all players in the group, each player should immediately return to their team's transportation vehicle. Score cards do not need to be signed and attested. Coaches should collect their teams' scorecards at the vehicle. Please verify the accuracy of the each scorecard. Coaches are then responsible returning their cart and for depositing all of their teams' completed and verified scorecards in the box near the pro shop.

11. Teams should depart the golf course as soon as the scorecards are turned in. There will be no scoreboard or awards ceremony. Results of the event will be emailed later in the day to your email address and to the media.

COVID-19 Spectator Protocols

1. Spectators are limited to 2 per player.
2. Spectators must sign in at the table near the clubhouse (necessary if the Board of Health needs to do contact tracing).
3. Spectators must consent to a temperature and COVID-19 symptom check before being permitted on the course.
4. Spectators must wear a facial covering at all times.
5. Spectators must avoid congregating in large groups near the players and coaches.
6. Spectators must leave the facility immediately following the round, there will be no scoreboard or awards ceremony so there is no need to stay.
