

**2019 Boys Division I Sectional Golf Tournament
at Sweetbriar Golf Course (Legacy Course)**

USGA Rules of Golf govern all play except where local rules apply.

- Boys will play from the **Black Tees**
- All water hazards are defined by red stakes or lines, and will be played as Lateral Hazards.
- All bridges are in the hazard – no relief
- Out of bounds is defined by white stakes
- All home-site property is out of bounds.
- Out of Bounds is defined by the sidewalk on the following holes:
 - 2, 3, 4 and 15
- The chain link fence defines out of bounds on holes 8 and 9
- The driving range and fencing down the left side of hole 18 is out of bounds
 - There is no relief from the out of bounds fencing
- The posts with ropes attached in hazards can be moved if necessary, please make sure the posts are replaced after the shot
- All fescue will be marked as a lateral hazard
- All tree stumps and ground out tree stumps are ground under repair, player receives free relief, one club length, no closer to the hole.
- Free relief is allowed from all roadways, cart paths, sprinklers, drains, flowerbeds and ornamental trees (under three feet tall)
- Drop areas are located on holes 4, 7 and 13
- Before signing your score card please check in with the Rules committee with any questions. The committee will make the final decision.

- Playoff procedures:
 - Golfers begin on hole 1
 - Continue onto hole 9, 10, 18 (if necessary)

Reminder- All state of Ohio coaching rules are in effect.

- **Only the head coach (1) may speak with their players.**
- **Please remind spectators to keep their distance and not talk to the players.**
- **Carts available for Coaches Only; No Spectators**
- **No course shuttling service this year; Coaches can but no riders on back.**
