- 1. You are keeping score for everyone in the group. Please write your name on your card. Please write scores legible manner.
- 2. We need scorecards after 9 holes to post UNOFFICIAL scores. We will get them back to you promptly.
- 3. After the completion of play, we ask the group to go over everyone's scores. You do not have to sign your card or add up any total score. All questions regarding rules and or scoring should be acknowledged before turning in your card. If there is a scoring discrepancy, we will look at all cards to determine if there is a common score.
- 4. Rules for the day:
 - A. Stroke Play from the White Tees
 - B. Lift clean and place within 1 club length in your own fairway. Must stay in fairway cut.
 - C. Embedded Ball Rule is in Effect through the green. (Through the green means NO hazards)
 - D. Freshly mulched areas including pine straw and flower beds may be played as ground under repair.
 - E. Tall un-mowed areas will be treated as a penalty area.
 - F. Ground dug up by animals or construction vehicles should be played as ground under repair.
 - G. The cement/black top around the clubhouse, cart facility and maintenance building is O.B. Cart path around 10 tee is in play.
 - H. Drop area on hole #4 for balls lost in the penalty areas on the left and right hills.
 - I. Free drop from fence behind #7 green. Drop area located short of the right bunker.
 - J. The path between the lakes on #18 is in the penalty area. You may not drop in this area.
 - K. When in doubt, play 2 balls, but you must declare which ball you want to count **BEFORE** playing the second ball.
- 8. We have spotters on a lot of holes. They will not find every ball hit so help them out. Point in the direction of your drive so they have a better chance of finding it.
- 9. **Do not ask a spotter for rules help**. Play 2 balls whenever there is a problem, but declare which ball you want to count before playing them.
