You have been assigned to the Sectional Golf Tournament at Stone Ridge Golf Course. The tourney will be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2020 Coaches meeting will be at 8:00 am with the first tee times scheduled to begin at 8:30 am sharp. The greens fees for the day will be \$150 and will be paid by the competing schools. Checks need to be made out to Stone Ridge Golf Club and preferably sent to the golf course ahead of the date of the tournament. The fee includes the green fees, range balls for day of the tournament a hot dog lunch for the golfers and the coach and a coach's golf cart. Practice rounds should be set up directly with the golf course. Practice round rates are: Monday-Thursday \$15 walking/\$25 riding with cart per 18. Weekend rates (Friday-Sunday) are \$25 walking/\$30 with cart per 18. Practice round range balls are the responsibility of the players/coach. Weekend times need to be after noon. Coaches and chaperones can play for the same rate. Golfers must be at least 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license to rent a cart. Practice rounds are the school's responsibility.

Baumspage information in regards to: 1) setting up your coaches account (for new coaches, returning coaches should use their account info etc.. from last year to access their account) is listed with directions to enter your rosters, 2) Rules of the course, 3) tee time assignments, 4) information regarding green fees for practice rounds and 5) team scoresheets are all listed on the baumspage site for this tournament. Go to baumspage .com and scroll down the tournament listings for the Division I sectional tournaments in the Northwest district and click on the Stone Ridge link. These documents have been uploaded on the page and can be accessed by both coaches and the general public. Spectator carts will be available for \$25. Covid 19 has changed some of the procedures for the tournament this year. Scorecard distribution, scoring and collection of scores will be different and explained at the coach's meeting. Your help will be asked in regards to spectators for your various schools as the OHSAA is charging admission to the golf tournament this year. Cost will be \$8 per person. Online ticketing thru your athletic department and athletic director is going to used. This information has been sent to you and is similar in regards to tickets for other fall sports (ie. Football and volleyball) Tickets will be checked and scanned as they enter the course parking lot. Social distancing will be necessary especially around the club house, practice range and putting green.

Advise your coach that the window for player entries opens 9:00 am on September 13th and will close 10:00 pm on September 30th. I look forward to seeing you on the 6th. of October!
