- U.S.G.A. Rules will govern all play unless otherwise noted on this rules sheet.
- Play will be from the Blue Tees.
- No conversations can occur with spectators during play unless the spectators are assisting in search for potential Lost Ball.
- 4. All hazards and ground under repair are marked accordingly:
  - a. Water Hazard Yellow Lines and/or Stakes
  - b. Lateral Hazard Red Lines and/or Stakes Ground Under Repair – White Lines
- 5. Any ball coming to rest in an area where the grass is browned out our there is bare dirt = FREE RELIEF.
  - a. Lift and drop outside of the area no nearer the hole.
- Any areas that the turf is torn away by animals are considered G.U.R. and players make take complete relief from the area, no nearer the hole. These areas may or may not be marked.
- 7. If a ball in play lies in an area that is questionable for G.U.R. and is not marked, inform your playing competitors and play a 2<sup>nd</sup> ball under the relief rule for G.U.R. and consult with the Rules Official at the end of play to determine the ruling.
- 8. Casual Water and the Embedded Ball Rule are in effect through the green.
- 9. The Naturalized Areas on Holes #3, #4, #5, #6 and #7 will be played as a Lateral Hazard
- 10. Hole #1 OUT OF BOUNDS begins with cart path along cart building and extends to Posts along the Driving Range. The Wooden Posts mark the O.B. for the length of the Driving range.
- Hole #7 OUT OF BOUNDS begins at corner of naturalized area left of fairway and the steel fence on left side.
- 12. Holes #14 and #15 The Out-of-Bounds is defined by the inside edge of the split rail fencing along the left side.
- 13. Hole #17 The entire left side will be played as Lateral Hazard
- 14. Hole #18 The Maintenance Area will be played as G.U.R. and will be marked accordingly. Beyond the Maintenance Area, along the left side will be played as Lateral Hazard.
- 15. Scorecards Each player will score for a fellow competitor. All scorecards must be turned into the scorer's area immediately following play. Scorecards will require TWO SIGNATURES and players are signing that the HOLE-BY-HOLE SCORES are correct.
- 16. Advancing from Sectional to District
  - (3) Teams and (4) Individuals, not on qualifying teams will advance to the District Tournament at Red Hawk Run in Findlay, Ohio.
