Ohio High School Athletic Association Guidelines

- 1. Coaches must enter their players on both the Baumspage and iWanamaker websites.
- Each player will keep the official paper scorecard for one other player in the group and will also
 record scores after completing play on each hole on the iWanamaker site. Coaches and Players
 should familiarize themselves with the iWanamaker site. Players should only use their phones for
 scoring during play.
- 3. Spectators will be charged a fee of \$8. Students spectators will pay \$6. You must purchase tickets on the Hometown Ticketing App.....all money is forwarded to the OHSAA.
- 4. Spectators may rent a golf cart for a fee of \$25 payable to Valley View. Spectators must remain half a hole behind the players and may not converse with players.
- 5. Range finder devices are permitted to determine yardage only.
- 6. Playoffs will break ties for third place for individuals and teams so teams must stay at the course until qualifying teams and individuals are determined.

Valley View Guidelines

- 1. Tee times will begin at 9 am off both nines. Tee times will be posted when all entries have been received, so please enter as soon as possible.
- 2. Each team will be assigned one golf cart. Only one coach is permitted to converse with players during play. Coaches may not converse with players on greens or in sand traps.
- 3. Range balls are included in the entry fee. You will be given tokens for balls.
- 4. A sandwich, chips, and a drink are also included in the entry.
- 5. Girls will play red tees on all holes. Players may improve their lie only in their own fairway, apron or approach. Ball must be played within a scorecard length no nearer the hole. Balls in rough must be played as they lie unless marked as ground under repair.
- 6. Lost ball and out of bounds is stroke and distance only.
- 7. Free drop from flower beds, but not ornamental grass.
- 8. Drop areas are on 2, 9, 16, 17
- 9. Players must hole out on each hole or they will be given a maximum score of 12 on each hole.
- 10. The tournament entry will be paid by the Northwest District Athletic Board.
- 11. You can call Valley View at 419-468-1226 to make tee times for practice rounds. Green Fees for practice rounds will be \$14.
