Pike Run Golf Club Local Rules and Description.

UGSA rules apply to all players except when local rules apply.

Players will play blue tees. Course will be set up at approx. 6200 yards

All natural grass areas are to be played as hazard areas. Free relief from all staked trees or young trees.

Free relief from all mulched areas.

Drop areas on #12 and #14 can be used if ball enters water on tee shot.

Perimeter post mark out of bounds. Ball is considered OB even if on course but across road. Example playing #7 and ball crosses OB stakes and is on #8.

If ball lands in driving range, it is in play and should be played from where it lies.

All players MUST use tunnel when crossing to other side of road.

#13 New Green Area... All players must take relief from the roped area. If on new green take ball equal distance from pin on existing green. If in rough drop ball in drop area in front of green

Description - Helps

#1 Par 5 Water on left over hill; natural area on right and left.

#2 Par 4 Water right of green; natural areas right and left .

#3 Par 3.

- #4 Par 4 Water and natural area on left.
- #5 Par 5 Natural area off tee on left; OB on left.

#6 Par 4 OB on left.

#7 Par 4 OB on left; natural area on right.

#8 Par 4 OB on left; natural area on right and in front of tee.

#9 Par 3 OB on left; natural area on right and in front of tee.

#10 Par 4 OB on left; natural area on right up near green.

#11 Par 4 Natural area on left off tee; OB on left; creek at bottom of hill.

#12 Par 3 Drop area across creek may be used if ball hit in water.

#13 Par 4 Creek on left and runs across fairway; pond on right; OB over green.

#14 Par 3 Creek on right; OB on left; drop area may be used if ball hit into water.

#15 Par 4 OB on left; natural area on right.

#16 Par 4 OB on left; water on right; natural area over green.

#17 Par 4 Water on right and left; natural are right past water.

#18 Natural area on right; pond on left; natural area past pond.
