Attention Spectators:

The Ohio High School Athletic Association establishes the rules and procedures for high school golf in the state of Ohio. Please comply with the following rules.

- 1. Spectators are permitted on the course but must abide with OHSAA Rules. Electronic communication devices must be turned off!
- 2. A spectator may watch any group during play, but cannot talk to any player or give aid.
- 3. It is suggested that spectators stay about one-half hole ahead of the group and help as forecaddies.
- 4. Helping to look for a lost ball to speed play is both permitted and encouraged.
- 5. Please stay out of range of errant shots. Neither Miami Whitewater Forest Golf Course, Tournament Management, the SWDAB, nor the OHSAA accepts any liability for injuries sustained while on the premises. Spectators will be required to sign a waiver at Miami Whitewater Forest Golf Course.

6. <u>Spectators should not attempt to interpret rules or give aid as</u> <u>their "assistance" could lead to DISQUALIFICATION!</u>

- 7. Spectators <u>MUST</u> walk unless you are covered under ADA and then you could purchase an 18 hole cart and sign a ADA waiver.
- 8. Any one entering the park and/or golf course will need a Motor Vehicle Permit. An annual pass is \$10.00 and daily pass is \$3.00 (Available only Park Entrances with tech booths. Not at the Golf course itself).
