The Hamilton Elks Girls Division I Sectional Golf Tournament will be played on the **Red** and **White** Courses on Monday, September 30, 2019 starting at 8:30 AM. Rain date: Tuesday, October 1st.

- 1. The Official OHSAA Entry Form will be submitted online at www.baumspage.com!
- 2. Eligibility Certificates are not required.

The Online Entry Form must be submitted online before 8:00 PM, Saturday, September 28th. The entry window opens at 2:00 PM, Sunday, Sept. 15th!

- 1. The Online Entry Form at www.baumspage.com is the official OHSAA Entry Form.
 - a) You will need to create an account to entries. Please do so early!
 - b) User accounts/passwords from last year were retained. Associations with sports were cleared.
 - Underclassmen were advanced one grade and retained. Please delete athletes that did not return this year.
- 2. Click the Online Entry link at the www.baumspage.com.
 - a) Click on Login if you already have an account or Apply to create a new account!
 - b) Use Coaches | Select Teams to select your School and Sport.
 - i) On Select School Type | click High School | click Get Schools/Clubs
 - ii) Highlight your school | click Get Available School Teams
 - iii) On Select Sport | select HS Girls Golf | click Make me the Coach
 - c) Use Coaches | Golf | Modify Athletes to enter alphabetic roster.
 - d) Use Coaches | Golf | Submit Rosters to enter tournament.
 - i) Please submit your golfers in playing order!
 - b) Use the **Contact Us** link on Baumspage if there are problems.
- 3. Greens Fees \$25 per player must be paid prior to tee-off the day of the tournament.
 - a) Make check payable to **Hamilton Elks Golf Club.** Mail to: **Sean Arthur, PGA Director of Golf**, Hamilton Elks Lodge #93, 4444 Hamilton Middletown Rd., Hamilton, Ohio 45011
- 4. Call the Pro Shop **(513-887-4384)** to schedule a practice round. Please make sure your players dress appropriately.
 - a) Please note: Practice rounds may be scheduled in advance at non-peak hours.
 - b) There are several leagues during the week, so please check with the pro shop in advance.
 - i) It's possible that Friday and weekend afternoons/evenings may work best.
- 5. The Hamilton Elks Lodge has a policy that no food be brought in by teams and spectators.
 - a) You may bring-in coolers with water and soft drinks.
 - b) The snack bar will be open with a typical menu and possibly some specials..
