

Xenia Division II Girls Sectional Golf Tournament WGC GOLF COURSE Rules and Procedures

18 Hole individual stroke play, four scores out of five will count towards qualifying. Exchange scorecards prior to starting your round. You are responsible for your hole-by-hole scores being correct. Each card must have two signatures, that of the competitor and the marker. Prior to the start of play make sure your golf ball has an identifying mark on it and that you identify it with your fellow competitors.

USGA and **OHSAA** Rules govern all play

Please Note OHSAA Rule: A golfer may pick up their ball at any point during the round, but will be disqualified as soon as they choose to do so. However, he/she should continue to play with his/her group to finish the round. From the point of pick up, each hole thereafter should be marked on the scorecard as "N/A".

LOCAL RULES ADDENDUM

Play will be governed by the OHSAA and USGA Rules of Golf. **Pace of Play**: 4:30- please keep up with the group in front of you.

Tee Markers: GOLD MARKERS

Yardages Measured to the center of the green.

Natural Areas: Are considered through the green, play the ball as it lies.

Doubt as to Procedure: Under Rule 3.3, announce your intentions to play second ball and which ball will score if the rules permit, putt both balls out, record both scores, and get a ruling before signing your scorecard.

You must report the facts to the committee before signing your scorecard.

The Embedded Ball Rule: Is in effect through the green.

Out of Bounds: Defined by the inside edge of white painted lines. A ball which crosses Country Club Drive and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even though it may come to rest on another part of the course.

Ground Under Repair: Defined by white lines, except balls drops and all flower beds. Flower beds to the right of #4 green are considered out of bounds.

Scorecards: MUST be turned in immediately after your round at the scoring table in the Pro Shop.

COURSE HAZARDS AND OUT OF BOUNDS

HOLE #1	Out of bounds right and Red Penalty Areas Right and Left
HOLE #2	Out of bounds Right
HOLE #3	Out of bounds Right
HOLE #4	Out of bounds Right and Hazard behind green.
HOLE #7	Yellow Penalty Area: Ball in pond, proceed to drop area, also Red Penalty Area on right
HOLE #9	Out of bounds Right and Behind Green
HOLE #10	Out of bounds Right, Red Penalty Area behind green. Drop Area Available.
HOLE #11	Yellow Penalty Area and Out of bounds Far Right
HOLE #12	Out of bounds Right and Behind Green, Red Penalty Area Far Left.
HOLE #13	Red Penalty Area Left
HOLE #14	Out of bounds Right
HOLE #17	Out of bounds Right
HOLE #18	Out of bounds Right and Behind Green

ALL OHSAA AND SWDAB RULES WILL BE ENFORCED! The OHSAA coaching and electronics rule are in effect! A player will be disqualified for riding in a cart or having a caddy in any capacity. Any tobacco use by participants will result in disqualification.

QUALIFYING: 4 TEAMS AND 4 INDIVIDUALS NOT ON A QUALIFYING TEAM

WEATHER: Suspension of Play for Dangerous Situation: 1 Prolonged Air Horn Note.

STOP PLAY IMMEDIATELY or PENALTY DISQUALIFICATION.

When play is suspended, all practice areas are closed until the Committee declares them open.
