## Spectator Guidelines


# Thanks for coming out and supporting Golf in the Miami Valley!

To Help Ensure a Smooth Round for Everyone we require that Spectators.....



- Stay on our around cart paths and when cart paths
   are not available please stay a reasonable distance from the players (at
   least 25 yards).
- Spectators MAY NOT walk up to the green to watch and please avoid being in field of vision when contestants are playing.
- Cell phones must be either turned off or their ringers turned to the silent mode.

  Be careful with the vibration mode as well
- Spectators <u>MAY NOT</u> carry participant's umbrella, apparel, equipment or food and water. That is the Coaches Reasonability
- Spectators <u>MAY SEARCH</u> for player's golf ball but not identify the ball for the contestant (Just point it's location out)
- Spectators shall not interfere in the play of a participant. This includes, but is not limited to:
- A. Asking a player what their score was.
- B. Giving rulings or advice to any player.
- C. Providing yardage
- D. Verbal communication with the participant
- E. Hand signals to the participant
- F. Providing participants with written material
- G. Positioning yourself as a spectator to assist the player with aim or alignment.
- · Spectators may politely applaud and offer encouragement.
- Violations may result in penalties or disqualifications of contestants.
