



Any ball coming to rest in a parking lot, on or over neighborhood roads or sidewalks, in the cart corral, or in the maintenance facility area is to be considered out of bounds.

***There are no drop areas between water & greens. If a player's ball crosses a yellow margin and comes to rest in a hazard marked yellow, the player must legally drop and hit over the hazard.

Front Nine:

Hole #1 --OB stakes right side at residential property lines.

--If a ball comes to rest in the mown area of the driving range or driving range tee, it is

out of bounds.

Hole #2 -- OB stakes along residential property lines

Hole #3 --OB stakes left side along residential property lines

--A ball that comes to rest anywhere to the right of the cart path is out of bounds

Hole #4 --yellow penalty area short of fairway

--red penalty area left of fairway

--yellow penalty area short of green

--A ball that comes to rest anywhere to the right of the cart path is out of bounds

Hole #5 -- A ball that comes to rest on or over the road is out of bounds

--yellow penalty area short of fairway

--red penalty area left of fairway

--yellow penalty area short of green

Hole #6 --OB stakes along residential property lines

--A ball that comes to rest on or over the road is out of bounds

Hole #7 -- OB stakes along residential property lines

--A ball that comes to rest on or over the road is out of bounds

Hole #8 -- OB stakes along residential property lines

--A ball that comes to rest on or over the road is out of bounds

Hole #9 -- OB stakes along residential property lines

ON THE ENTIRE GOLF COURSE

All mulch beds and heather must be played as is. There are no free drops from these areas.

--A ball that comes to rest to the left of the cart path after crossing the bridge is out of

All players, if necessary, must use the OHSAA local rule of a 12 stroke limit on all holes. After hitting their 12th shot on a hole, a player should pick up and record their score as a 12. They then go to the next tee and play on. Their score still counts (not a DQ).

Everyone must use live scoring from iWanamaker. It is not optional. Your OFFICIAL SCORE will be the one recorded on your paper scorecard. After 18 holes your entire group should go directly to the scoring area to have the official paper scorecard checked, signed, and attested.
