

# Rules of Play

## PLAY:

USGA and OHSAA rules govern all play.

## VIOLATIONS:

- a. **Tobacco:** Participants (coach, players, managers, etc) are prohibited from using any form of tobacco on the golf course, in the clubhouse, or anywhere on Pleasant Hill facilities during any tournament. Penalty for any violation of this rule will be disqualification.
- b. **Conduct:** A two-stroke penalty shall be assessed for unsportsmanlike conduct. Unsportsmanlike conduct shall include but not be limited to club throwing, willful acts which damage property or equipment, use of abusive, language, profanity, obscenities, and other unsportsmanlike conduct as determined by the Golf Rules Committee. Penalties imposed may result in disqualification.
- c. **Cell phones:** Participants, coaches, and spectators are not permitted to use cell phones during play. Phones in a player's possession must be turned-off during the round! Penalties imposed may result in disqualification.

## OUT OF BOUNDS:

All Out of Bounds areas are marked by white stakes and fence. Out of Bounds behind #1, #3, #10, and #17, Left on #4, #5, #6, #7, and #8, Right on #11, #13, and #18.

## LOCAL RULES:

- Hole #7: Ball in water from tee -- Play from drop area.  
Hole #17: Ball in water from tee -- Play as regular or lateral hazard.  
Ball in water from fairway or rough -- Play from first drop area.  
Ball in water from first drop area -- Play from second drop area by green.

## DROP AREAS:

Ball must be dropped in drop areas.

## TEES:

All play will be from the white tees.

## YARDAGE MARKERS:

- 200 yards: Marked with blue painted line on cart path.  
150 yards: Marked with white painted line on cart path and white stakes.  
100 yards: Marked with red painted line on cart path.  
Par 3s: White yardage is from the cement block on the tee.  
All yardages measured to center of the green.

## QUESTIONABLE PLAY:

If there is any doubt as to the proper procedure of play, announce your intentions play second ball, putt both balls out, and record both scores. **Before signing** the scorecard, **the player MUST report the facts** to the committee **and get a ruling!** Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

## SCORECARDS:

Write scores of player whose name is on the label in the top 2 boxes. **After nine** holes, report the score of the card you are keeping to the scorers' table inside the clubhouse. When you finish eighteen, go to the scorers' table to figure your scorecard, sign and attest scorecards. **You are responsible for the hole-by-hole score on your own scorecard.**
