Welcome to Eagle Rock!

Today's event will be played by USGA rules. WHITE Tees. Summer Rules. Special notes:

- 1. Out of bounds is defined by white stakes on most front nine holes (1,2,3,4,5,6,and 7) and some back nine holes (10,11,13,14,15,and 16)
- 2. **Red stakes** indicate lateral hazard. Included in this hazard designation is the hill to the left of the creek on # 7 and over the green on #5.
- 3. Free relief from mulched trees, flower beds and cart paths... nearest point of complete relief (including stance) plus one club length.
- 4. **Special local rule.** On hole number 6 only. You may clean debris from around your ball if you are in the bunker, such as leaves, hickory nuts, etc. Do not move your ball.
- 5. Embedded ball rule is in effect through the green.
- 6. White marking indicates ground under repair (free relief one club length).
- 7. The utility line on # 7 could come into play by the green. If your ball strikes the power line during play on the hole, the stroke is cancelled and the player must play a ball as nearly as possible from the spot where the original ball was played. No penalty.
- 8. There are mandatory drop areas for holes number 2 and 8 if the ball is in the hazard on number 3. 1 stroke penalty
- 9. Rulings will be made by Jacob Von Deylen, Tournament Director.
- 10. If you have any questions, play two balls and the tournament director will make the ruling when play is finished.
- 11. Please replace divots and repair ball marks.

Note: In case of bad weather, we will sound a horn. Play will be suspended. Mark your ball with a tee and return to the clubhouse. There are storm shelters by 14 and 15 greens if you are unable to make it back to the clubhouse.

Lunch will be provided after play is completed. Your coach will have your lunch ticket. Players should report to the scorer's area to sign and verify scorecards before eating. Thank you and good luck!
