Entry Procedures and Deadlines

Friday, February 8, to Mr. Conzaman at Walsh Jesuit High School

- 1) OHSAA Eligibility Certificates
- 2) OHSAA Wrestling Certification Alpha Master Report
- 3) OHSAA Entry Form

Wednesday, February 18, by 7:00 p.m.

- 1) Online roster and seed nomination form (see instruction page)
- 2) Include grade and record of all wrestlers
- 3) All wrestlers with winning record should be listed on the seed nomination form

Thursday, February 19, at 7:00 p.m.

- 1) Coaches' Meeting Room 101 – Walsh Jesuit High School
- 2) Brackets will be drawn during the meeting

Weigh-Ins

1. Friday, February 20, at 4:00 p.m. Do not report to Walsh Jesuit until after 3:00 p.m. Park all buses behind the school.
2. All OHSAA skin authorizations, signed and dated, must be presented at weigh-ins.
3. The weigh-in shall proceed through weight classes beginning at 103 lbs. and end immediately upon completion of 285 lbs. A contestant may step on and off the first scale two times; if he fails to make weight on the first scale, he shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight.
4. Second day weigh-ins will start when the 140 lb. quarterfinals begin (approximately 7:30 p.m.) and continue 30 minutes after the final match of the evening.

Draw of Non-seeded Wrestlers

Non-seeded wrestlers will be drawn in alphabetical order of school name, as listed in the OHSAA directory. The order of the draw will be rotated for successive weights.

Redraw Procedure on Tournament Day

If a seeded wrestler drops out or fails to make weight:

- 1) The seeds will be moved up to the proper line.
- 2) If the bye created is legal, it will be left as is.
- 3) If the bye is not legal, the non-seeded wrestlers and byes will be redrawn.

Coaches, Wrestlers, and Administrator Admissions

- 1) Each school will receive six wristbands for admission and hospitality room for coaches, statisticians, scorekeepers, etc. All others must pay.
- 2) Tickets for the wrestlers will be given to the head coach at the coaches' meeting on Thursday, February 19.
- 3) Superintendent, Principal, Athletic Director, and their guest will be admitted at the pass gate.

Please check with your district qualifiers to confirm that the data listed on the qualifier form is correct. The top four in each weight will qualify to the District Tournament at Akron Firestone. The Fifth Place finisher will be the alternate. Please notify the District Manager ASAP if you know your qualifier will not be able to compete in the District Tournament. Four (4) wrestlers from the Akron Firestone Division II District will qualify for the State Tournament.
