

BEDFORD DISTRICT TRACK AND FIELD MEET INFORMATIONAL SHEET

1. Entries must be submitted in Baumspage prior to Sunday, May 13th at 10:30 PM. In addition, OHSAA Tournament Entry Forms must be completed on MyOHSAA. Late entries MUST be approved by the OHSAA and these entries will be placed in slower heats.
2. If necessary, there will be a coaches meeting at 3:30 PM on Thursday.
3. Only 1/4" or smaller spikes will be allowed.
4. The infield MUST remain clear at all times. Coaches and athletes found in the infield will be asked to leave the area immediately. Repeated offenses will result in disqualification.
5. Four boys and four girls will qualify to the Regional Meet at Austintown Fitch.
6. Participants must be in their uniform to enter. All others must pay admission.
7. Depending on the number of entrants in the 1600, 3200, and 800 there may not be semi-finals in these races on Thursday. The games committee will make the decision on Monday, May 14th, and the updated schedule will be posted on Baumspage by Tuesday.
8. Shot and discus must be weighed in prior to beginning competition. Once the competition begins, all implements must remain at the site until competition is completed that day.
9. In accordance with OHSAA rules, contestants must adhere to uniform restrictions.
10. The area where it is illegal to remove any part of the uniform is inside the fence that surrounds the track and stadium field. For the shot and discus, this includes the area containing these events.
11. Chalk and tennis balls are the only markers to be used on the runways and track. No tape or other marking devices are permitted.
12. NO COACHES OR SPECTATORS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE HIGH JUMP OR LONG JUMP AREAS. DESIGNATED VIEWING AREAS WILL BE POSTED.
13. Competitors may check in with the clerks at the north end of the track. All running events (except for the 200m Dash and 300m Hurdles) will be checked in that area. The 200m Dash and 300m Hurdles will be checked in at their respective start area.
14. Please do not arrive at Bedford prior to 2:30 PM on Thursday, May 18. Early arrivals will not be permitted to enter the school parking lot until school dismissal has been completed.
15. An air horn will be used to recall a race if there is malfunction of the FAT system. The FAT operator will be provided with the air horn and in charge of recalling the race if necessary.
