STADIUM INFORMATION GUIDE

GENERAL:

Whitehall City Schools prohibits tobacco use on school grounds, including parking lots. Team camps will be located in the baseball outfield. The team pass gate will be located to the right of the north main home stadium gate. Signs will be posted. Please help us keep our grounds clean by cleaning up any trash at your team camp areas after the event. Whitehall's stadium has a grass surface and athletes are requested to stay off the playing field. We ask that the athletes warm up on the back side of the track and not on the football field. Only competing athletes are permitted inside the track in close proximity to their event times. Athletes should not become spectators inside the track.

BUS ACCESS:

Team buses should enter from our North driveway and proceed to the back of the school and drop off the athletes at the Team Pass Gate in front of the stadium entrance. Buses will then be directed to park on the South side of the tennis courts. Once the day's events have concluded buses will proceed out the South driveway onto Yearling Rd.

DIRECTIONS:

Whitehall-Yearling High School is located at 675 S Yearling Rd, Whitehall, Ohio 43213.

From the North:

Take I-71 South towards Columbus; go east on I-270 to the Broad St. exit (West - Downtown); pass Hamilton Rd. and turn left at Yearling Rd. (Holy Spirit Catholic Church is on the corner), proceed 1 mile and turn right in the north driveway.

From the South:

Take I-71 north towards Columbus; go east on I-270 to the to the Main St. 2nd exit (Whitehall); pass over Hamilton Rd. and turn right at the first light which is Yearling Rd. Proceed 1/4 mile and turn left into the schools north driveway.

From the East:

Take I-70 west towards Columbus; go east on I-270 to the to the Main St. 2nd exit (Whitehall); pass over Hamilton Rd. and turn right at the first light which is Yearling Rd. Proceed 1/4 mile and turn left into the schools north driveway.

From the West:

Take I-70 East towards Columbus to the Hamilton Rd, North exit (Whitehall); go north on Hamilton Rd to Main St and turn left and proceed to the first light which is Yearling Rd. and turn right. Proceed 1/4 mile and turn left into the schools north driveway.

PARKING/GATES: Parking is available in lots located on the west side of the school near the stadium entrance, also along the west side of the building by the baseball field, on the south side of the school and along the east front entrance to the building. The church parking lot located on the south side of the school and the administration building lot on the north side of the school will serve as over-flow lots. Spectators may use the north main home stadium gates and also our south visitor gate located behind the baseball home dugout. District/OHSAA Pass holders will need to enter through the on the north main home stadium gates.

TICKET PRICES: Ticket prices for the Central District Athletic Board events are \$6.00 for all spectators. Credit/debit cards cannot be accepted. Ticket sales will open one hour before the meet begins.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be offered by the Rams Sports Club and our Band Boosters during all stadium events.

PASSES: Athletes, managers and statisticians must be in uniform. All coaches and bus drivers are required to be on the CDAB tournament entry pass list and enter at the **team entry gate**. All events are located within the stadium so there is no need for re-entry to the event. School administrators may use their Central District Athletic Board passes at our north main stadium ticket gate to enter the event.

PRESSBOX: No space will be made available in the press box.

TEAM CAMPS: Team camps will be allowed in the Baseball outfield area. No camps will be allowed in the South bleachers.

COACHING BOXES: Field event coaches should have access to their athletes. All field events at Whitehall are in close proximity and within view of each other.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: In the case of inclement weather, teams should return to their buses. If the buses are not available, we will find a safe location for your athletes and coaches. All spectators will need to return to their cars.

SPECTATORS: Handicap seating is available at the stadium.

RESTROOMS: Restrooms are next to the north concession stand and portable restrooms are located near the south concession stand.

ATHLETIC TRAINERS: There will be an Athletic Trainer on site and we will provide coolers of water and ice for injuries. In adherence to State Licensure laws governing athletic training services, our Athletic Trainers will be happy to provide taping for visiting athletes with written individual documentation from your athletic trainer or a physician as to the type of taping necessary. In the event you need these services, please bring the appropriate taping supplies and documentation with you.
