MEET INFORMATION

1. Spikes may be no longer than ¼ inch.
2. Medals will be awarded to top six (6) places in each event.
3. Trophies will be presented to the top two (2) teams.
4. Medals and trophies will be handed out to coaches at completion of meet.
5. Field events will start at 9:00 a.m..
6. In the Long Jump, Shot Put, and Discus, four (4) attempts will be given to all contestants.
NO FINALS
7. Running events will begin at 10:00 AM with the Girls and Boys 4 X 8 followed by the semis of the 100 m Dash, 100 LH, 110 Hurdles and 200 M Dash
8. Coaches, please remind your athletes that they should not leave their field event until the second call, and to be sure to check in and out with the field event judge when leaving and returning.

9. The 1600, 800, 400, 200 hurdles, 4 X 100, 4 X 200, and 4 X 400 may be contested in times sections.
10. Coaches, please remind your athletes that they must sit on the hillside, or grass outside the east side of the track. The bleachers are for paying spectators. Also, ask your athletes to clean up around their camp sight. We will provide plastic trash bags. Tents are welcome.
11. Athletes must turn in Pole Vault forms to the Pole Vault Event Judge.
12. A concession stand and t-shirt sale will be available.
13. Lunch will be provided free of cost to coaches and bus drivers in the building near the starting line. **FROM 11:00 AM – 2:00 pm**
14. We will have electronic timing.
