MEET INFORMATION

- 1. Spikes may be no longer than ¼ inch.
- 2. Medals will be awarded to top six (6) places in each event.
- 3. Trophies will be presented to the top two (2) teams.
- 4. Medals and trophies will be handed out to coaches at completion of meet.
- 5. Field events will start at 9:00 a.m.
- 6. Semifinals in running events will start at 10:15 a.m.
- 7. Finals in all running events will begin approximately 45 minutes after the last semifinal running event is contested.
- 8. In the Long Jump, Shot Put, and Discus, four (4) attempts will be given to all contestants.

- 9. The 1600, 800, 400, 200 Hurdles, 4x100, 4x200, and 4x400 may be contested in timed sections.
- 10. Coaches, please remind your athletes that they should not leave their field event until the second call, and to be sure to check in and out with the field event judge when leaving and and returning.
- 11. Coaches, please remind your athletes that they must sit on the hill side. The bleachers are for paying spectators. Also ask your athletes to clean up around their camp sight. We will provide plastic trash bags. Tents are welcome.
- 12. Athletes must turn in Pole Vault forms to the Pole Vault Event Judge.
- 13. A concession stand and t-shirt sale will be available.
- 14. Lunch will be provided free of cost to coaches in the high school cafeteria.
- 15. We will have electronic timing.
