A tentative time schedule is enclosed. All athletes may wear 1/8" spikes. Competitors in the shot and discus will be allowed to use their own implements. In the shot, discus, and long jump all competitors will be given three attempts, with the top seven going into the finals.

Entry Fee: \$150.00 entry fee payable to OGHS Athletic Department by April 11.

Entries: You may enter **three (3)** athletes and 2 relays per event and you will enter your participants @ <u>Baumspage.com</u>, then click to OG Hughes/Doty Junior High Invitational. Please use correct times for athletes as all events will be seeded. The entry window is March 27th and the entry window closes at 12:00 pm, Friday, April 14th. *Submit accurate entries before the window closes*. Meet timing will be ran by Tyler Closson. Please contact him at clossot@ottawaglandorf.org with any entry questions. Scratches and Substitutions will be made at the tent the day of the meet.

Track: We have an all-weather metric track with six 42-inch lanes. The long jump, pole vault, and high jump areas are asphalt and the shot and discus pads are concrete. **Only 1/8**" **spikes** are permitted on the all- weather surfaces. **No tape**, prefer chalk or tennis balls

Points: Six places will be scored as follows: 10-8-6-4-2-1.

Awards: Medals will be given to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers with ribbons going to the 4th, 5th, and 6th place finishers. <u>All awards other than team awards can be picked up at the finish line tent at the conclusion of the meet.</u>

Plaques will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place teams in the boys and girls divisions.

Meals: Sandwiches, snacks and beverages will be available at the concession stand. Coaches will receive a coupon for a sandwich and drink.
