- Each team is permitted two entries per event.
- Scratches/Changes made during the running events must be made by the coach at the Clerk of Course AND the upper field house. Field Events can be made at the event.
- Order of Events: Field and Running events begin at 5:00.

- All events will run as finals.
- Standard starting blocks will be provided.
- 1/4" spikes only - please purchase prior to meet.
- Tennis balls will be used for marking checkpoints. No chalk or tape. Teams should supply their own tennis balls and batons.
- Shot put and Discus: Bring your own.
- Team parking will be at the swimming pool parking lot east of track (see attached directions).
- Awards and results will be available at the field house shortly after the meet and presentation of team awards.
- Concession stand will be open throughout the day. Your patronage is appreciated.
- Admission: \$4 for everyone. No league passes will be accepted
- Please park your buses in the swimming pool parking lot. Map attached.
- Spectator parking will be available on the South and West side of the old high school, now our Board of Education. (459 S. Center Street)

Shot Put: Order of Competition: Boys, Girls - Four attempts only. Top eight place. (No Finals)

Discus: Order of Competition: Girls, Boys - Four attempts only. Top eight place. (No Finals)

Long Jump: Boys and Girls Open Pit for 1 hour, two pits. Girls Division at the NORTH Pit. Boys Division at the SOUTH Pit. Four attempts only. Top eight place. (No Finals)

High Jump: Order of Competition: We will use both pits. Girls at the East Pit, Boys at the west pit "Five Alive"
Opening height to be determined

Pole Vault: Order of Competition: Boys followed by Girls. "Five Alive"
Opening height to be determined

Running Events: Start at 5:00 PM

All running events are final. No Prelims

Changes made to the entries after the Baumspage deadline must be upon arrival in the upper press box until 4:15. Substitutions made during the meet must be made by the coach in the upper field house close to the track. The substitute athlete needs to notify the clerk of course or the field event official of the change too.

200M Hurdles and *200M Dash* runners report to the clerk on the outside of the track at their respective starting line.

All other runners report to the clerk at the NORTHWEST corner of the track.

Names of all qualifiers will be posted immediately after they are announced

STARTING LINES

All starting lines and common finish are in accordance with National Federation Rules along with markings on the track itself.
