Welcome you to the 5th annual, JH Tomahawk Track & Field Invitational. We are very excited to be hosting this event. We hope you enjoy the meet and that everything goes well for you and your team. The following packet contains important information that will help us all run a smooth meet.

- **Teams**: Archbold, Delta, Fairview, Fayette, Liberty Center, McCord, Ottawa-Glandorf, Toledo Christian, and Wauseon
- Entry Fee: \$175 per school (covers both genders)

Entries:2 entries per school per event. 1 entry per school for each relay.

Entry window closes: Thursday, April 4, 2024 – 7:00 pm
Scratches or changes: may be handled upon arrival

- **Running prelims:** Prelims will be run for the 100 hurdles, 110 hurdles, 100 dash, and 200 dash. The top 2 from each heat plus the next 5 best times qualify for the finals
- Field events:Shot put/discus/long jump 4 attempts NO FINALSHigh jump/pole vault starting heights listed on event schedule
- **Running Events:** All runners will check in with the clerk at the northwest end of the track. The gate will be open at the Bull Pen area. Once your race is completed all runners MUST exit the gate at the finish line.
- **Scoring:** Top 8 places will score
- **Awards**: Trophies will be presented to the champion and runner-up teams for each gender at the completion of the meet. Medals will be given to 1st place and certificates will be awarded to 2nd and 3rd place. Individual awards will be distributed to the coaches at the conclusion of the meet.
- **Coaches Meeting**: We will have a coaches meeting for information and scratches at 9:15 in the room on the north end of the field house. Heat sheets will be made available at that meeting.
- **Infield:** NO Spectators allowed inside of the track. Upon the conclusion of the high jump, there should be no coaches and non-participating athletes inside the track.
- **Buses**: 2 OPTIONS You may have your buses unload the athletes near the Ag. Building on the Southeast corner of the track or at the parking lot closest to the Middle School. We ask that buses then park in the parking lot located across the street from the athletic facility to the south of the track in front of our Board of

Education Office or in the lot on the northwest corner of campus near Glenwood Street.

- <u>Camp Area</u>: Camp sites will be assigned upon arrival and will be in the grassy areas outside of the track. Please pick up trash at your camp site when the meet has concluded. Please stay off the infield. Camps will NOT be permitted under the bleachers.
- Admission: All tickets \$5.00 League passes will be honored.
- **<u>Restrooms</u>**: Restrooms are located on the south end of the field house. We will also have portable toilets on site.
- **<u>Concessions</u>**: Concessions are located at the southwest corner of the field house.
- **Starting blocks**: Starting blocks will be provided, however, you are more than welcome to bring your own if you choose.
- **Spikes/Markings**: No spikes longer than ¼ inch for both running and field event areas. Tennis balls should be used to mark runways and relay marks. Chalk or tape may be used for the high jump please remove the tape when finished competing.
