On Friday, May 6, 2022, Rocky River High School will host the 46th Bell Invitational. You have indicated that you will participate in this meet. The meet will have the same events as a regular track meet. Each team will be allowed to enter three entries in all running and field events, except relays where one team entry is allowed. All entries will be made through Baum's Page online entry starting April 22. Instructions are included in this information packet.

Track Surface

River's track has an all-weather surface including long jump, pole vault and high jump areas. Use of ¼" spikes is permitted. Shot and discus pads are brushed cement.

Awards

There will be a permanent trophy for the 1st and 2nd place teams. In addition, there will be a trophy awarded to the school with the highest combined score, boys and girls. The most outstanding boy and girl athletes will also receive a special plaque. Awards will be distributed at the completion of the meet. Coaches should pick up all team awards.

No Heat Meeting

Since there are only 8 boys and 8 girls teams involved, a computer program will seed the athletes according to your submitted times through Baum's Page (www.baumspage.com). The deadline for entries is Wednesday, May 4th at 11:59pm. A scratch substitute period will close at 11:59pm on Thursday, May 5th. Please be sure to include substitute times.

The Coaches Meeting will be held promptly at 2:30pm May 6 for all coaches outside the Stadium Field House near the shot put practice area.

Heats will be set up on Thursday and will be in your packets when you arrive Friday afternoon. If times are not entered online by Wednesday, May 4th, you will not receive preferred lanes.

Running Qualifiers – The top 2 finishers from each heat and the 2 fastest times will qualify to go to the finals.

- Break will be at the conclusion of the 200M preliminaries.
- Finals will take place 45 minutes after the 200M preliminaries.

Start Times

Field events will begin at 3:00 pm and track events will begin at 4:00 pm.

Field Events

Boys and Girls pole vault will run concurrently. The boys pole vault will start at 9' and then 10', progressing by 6" to 13', then by 3" until a winner is decided. The boys high jump will begin at 5'3" and increased to 5'6", then raised by 2" increments to 6'. After 6', it will be raised by 1" increments until a winner is decided.

The boys and girls long jump will be open pit from 4:00pm – 6:00pm. Each participant will get four jumps.

The girls pole vault will start at 6', then 7', and after will progress by 6" until 8'6", then by 3" until a winner is decided. Girls high jump will begin at 4'3" and increased to 4'6", then raised by 2" increments to 5'. After 5', it will be raised by 1" increments until a winner is decided.

Preliminaries will be held in the discus and shot put with the top 9 performers proceeding to the finals. Tie breaking procedures will follow those recommended in the OHSAA Track and Field Coaches Manual.

1. Welcome
2. Instructions
3. Spikes- 1/4"
4. Marking of track-tongue depressors, tennis balls
5. No dressing facilities
6. Team buses
7. All events will be scored 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 (8 Place Scoring)
8. Results of each event will be posted on the side of the concession stand soon after the event is completed.
9. Relay Cards—once submitted, no additions. **You must fill in all the information requested. Members of relay teams must be designated prior to competing the first time. Have the lead runner bring the relay card to the clerk.**
10. Uniforms/Numbers- NF- rule 4-
11. Scratches —scratches shall be submitted to the Clerk of Course/head field event official.
12. Bell Check in: Report to the **Outside Field House** to pick up packets.
13. **Recommended starting Heights:**
The boys pole vault will start at 9', then 10', progressing by 6" to 13', then by 3" until a winner is decided. The boys high jump will begin at 5'3" and increase to 5'6", then raised by 2" increments to 6'. After 6', it will be raised by 1" until a winner is decided. The girls pole vault will start at 6', then 7', then 6" until 8'6", then by 3" until a winner is decided. Girls high jump will begin at 4'3" and increased to 4'6", then raised by 2" increments to 5'. After 5', it will be raised by 1" until a winner is decided.
14. Field event/running participants- **Report to both locations**, field event officials will not release participant until the second call of the running event. **All participants must be in the bullpen by the 3rd call or be scratched.**
15. Each school will use their own shot and discus.
16. Field events: the pole vault has a **90 second time limit** after called up. The shot put, discus, long jump, and high jump have a **60 second time limit** after called up.
17. A coach or a person authorized by the Board of Education must be present throughout the competition.
18. Do not wear spikes in the bleachers or building.
19. Stay off the turf field.
20. Please have your athletes place their trash in the waste cans and clean up after the meet around your team's area.
21. No Frisbees or footballs
22. No loud playing music in the stands or around the track area.
23. A trainer will be available.
24. Starting blocks will be available.

****Weather Emergency Procedure—Athletes will be moved to the high school Auditorium, coming through the Stadium doors on the northeast corner of the building. Buses will pick up at the Wagar Road entrance.**
