



38th Annual Ned Weingart Relays – Cleveland Heights High School

Saturday April 9, 2022

Welcome to the 38th Annual Ned Weingart Relays! This year's event will be held on Saturday, April 9th at Cleveland Heights High School.

Please note some changes/additions to this letter, including a schedule change. All changes are highlighted.

Start time: 9am-Field events begin; 9:30am Running events begin.

Coaches/Officials meeting will be held at 8:45 at the starting line

Following is the order of events. We've added 2 non-scored JV events this year: the boys' and girls' 4x100m relay and the boys' and girls' 1600m run, with the intention of allowing you to bring more athletes to our meet. Field events will be scored individually, not as relays.

Running Events

9:30 am start - rolling time schedule. In each event, girls run first, followed by boys:

100m hurdles (prelims)/110m hurdles (prelims)

100m dash (prelims)

4x100m relay (non-scored JV race)
1600m run (non-scored JV race)
4x800m relay
100 hurdles (finals)/110m hurdles (finals)
100m dash (finals)
4x200m relay
1600m run
4x100m relay
400m dash
300m hurdles
800m run
200m dash
Sprint Medley Relay (100m, 100m, 200m, 400m)
3200m run
4x400m relay

Scoring: 8 places scored (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1)

Trophies/awards: Trophies awarded to the top 2 teams per gender. Medals awarded to the top 3 placers per event. MVP plaques awarded to top female and male athletes as voted on by coaches at the conclusion of the meet.

Entry fee: \$200/team (boys and girls counted as separate teams). Make checks payable to Cleveland Heights Running Boosters. Checks can be mailed to:

Entries: 2 athletes per individual event; 1 team per relay event.

Team camps: Team camps may be set up in the open parking area located in the Northwest area of the stadium (see map – camp area is denoted by Blue rectangles). The visitor stands will also be available for visiting teams (please no tents in the stands).

Bathroom & Gym Access: there are several portable restrooms located under the home bleachers. Additionally, athletes will have access to the bathrooms and gym to stay warm. These are accessible through door 8.

Admission: Entrance to the track is on Lee Rd under the bleachers, not adjacent to the parking lot. There will be a \$5 fee per spectator (\$8 for a combined ticket that includes Friday's Weingart Jr meet). Individuals 12 and under are free. Online advanced purchase available here:

T-shirts: We will be selling commemorative Weingart Relay T-shirts for \$15 (short sleeved, dri-fit material). Supplies will be limited. Cash or credit card options available.

Concessions/Hospitality room: We will sell concessions (cash preferred) and provide a hospitality room for coaches this year.

Parking: Parking at the high school is free but very limited. Try the lot on the eastern side of the school (near the baseball fields), the side streets west of Lee Rd, or the large free lot across Cedar (behind the Cedar Lee Theatre, on the southwest corner of Cedar & Lee). Tell your families to arrive with enough time to walk to the track, the entrance to which is on Lee Rd under the bleachers, not adjacent to parking options. VERY LIMITED handicapped parking and an entrance to the visitor stands will be available in the western lot (between the building and the track – to access enter via Washington Blvd). Cars with handicapped tags can enter that lot from Cedar Rd only.

Buses: Buses will park at the Delisle Options Building: 14780 Superior Rd. Cleveland Heights, OH 44118 (0.8 miles from CHHS) Directions will be provided at drop-off.

Weingart Jr.: For the first time we will host an FAT Junior High meet on Friday, April 8th. Following is that letter. Please share with your middle school teams. Opportunities to run FAT times are rare for middle school and those times are needed to qualify to the Outdoor Middle School State Championship.
