## Changes for this year.

1. We are going to try a mixed $4 \times 400 \mathrm{~m}$ relay at the end of the meet. (Girl, Girl, Boy, Boy) Points are split with both genders.
2. We moved the order of events and started running at 5:00.

This will hopefully allow the meet to be over much sooner than last year.
3. We will start with the shuttle hurdles this year, then DMR (8-4-12-16). We figured not as many field eventers would be in this event.
4. We are going to use all four rings ( 2 shot / 2 disc) at the same time. Not all teams will throw out of the same ring. We are wanting to make sure we can still do 4 throws and get the events in before dark.
5. I will probably have room for a $B$ team in some relays (1-2). If you think you will have a possibility let me know. For example there will be $\mathbf{2}$ heats of $4 \times 200$.
6. Jesse Squire will be interviewing the winner again under tent and Medals will be awarded quickly when we have confirmation.
7. We will have food for all coaches under the pressbox.
8. We've always wanted to create the greatest experience possible for the athletes. We will attempt to do baskets again, athlete recognition, etc.

4:15-Girls \& Boys Disc, Girls LJ, Boys \& Girls HJ and PV (Two Pits),
Weigh Ins: We will NOT weigh implements, we will use the honor system.
Coaches Meeting: No Meeting - We will announce anything missed or I will talk to you personally.

Entry Forms: Entries will be done on Baumspage. Entries open now, close on April $\mathbf{1 8}^{\text {th }}$ at 8 p.m. All lane assignments will be seeded according to entered times!

Awards: Combined Program Bannera (Men's and Womens) Champion and Runner-up.
Champion \& Runner-up Medals to the whole team. (No Trophy)
Medals will be awarded for $1^{\text {st }}-5^{\text {th }}$ (Gold, Silver, \& Bronze $3^{\text {rd }} 5^{\text {th }}$, no other color).
They will get them after their race near the finish line. Barring no disqualifications.

Interviews: We will try again to have event winners be interviewed after getting their medals by Jesse Squire near the award stand. We will try to live stream, just not sure where.

Facilities: The track is an eight lane all weather surface as well as all runways and jumps. The shot/discus are concrete. Camps should be outside the track fence away from the finish line area. Maximum spike length is $1 / 4$ inch exposed spike!

Events: Most events are relays - three athletes per relay field event and four per running event. Hammer, 1600, 300 hurdles and 100 are one competitor. We will NO longer have triple jump. With one runway it is difficult to get all long jumpers done. Four attempts in shot, disc, long jump, and hammer.

Scoring: 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 (8 places)
Field Events: You will supply your own implements. (Subject to possible changes)
HJ starting heights B $-5^{\prime} 0$ then 5-4 then 2 " til 6-2 then $1 ", G-4$ '2 then $2 "$ til 5-0 then 1 "
PV - Boys Start at $8^{\prime} 6^{\prime \prime}$ to $9^{\prime} 6^{\prime \prime}$ to $10^{\prime} 6^{\prime \prime}, 6^{\prime \prime}$ thereafter (could change with weather)
PV - Girls Start at $6^{\prime}$ to $7^{\prime}, 8^{\prime}, 6^{\prime \prime}$ thereafter
