Each Coach's packet will contain relay cards for the running relays. Relay cards should be filled out and turned in when reporting to the bullpen. Any scratches or replacements can be made on the relay card and turned in to the bullpen prior to the event.

One entry per team is permitted in all individual events.

## Substitutions in individual running events must be reported to hy-tek operator by 1:00 PM, no subs will be permitted in the bullpen. Please submit your changes on the enclosed form.

Report to the competition area 15 minutes before your flight is scheduled to check progress of competing flight.

The long jump will be open pit. The boys will go first, from 12:30-2:00 and the girls will follow from 2:30-4:00. The length of each session may be adjusted if necessary. Warm-up time for boys and girls: 30 minutes prior to start of event.

Combined efforts of field events are totaled for determining places.
Substitutions in field events must be reported to hy-tek operator by 12:00. No substitutions will be permitted at the event. Please submit your changes on the enclosed form.

Starting heights
High jump: Boys $-5^{\prime} 3^{\prime}$ " increase $3^{\prime \prime}$ to $6^{\prime}$ then $1^{\prime \prime}$ increments Girls - 4' $3^{\prime \prime}$ increase 3 " to $5^{\prime}$ then $1^{\prime \prime}$ increments

Pole vault: Boys $-8^{\prime}$ increase $1^{\prime}$ ' to 10 ' then 6 " to 12 ' then 3 " increments Girls - $6^{\prime}$ increase $1^{\prime}$ to $8^{\prime}$ then $6^{\prime \prime}$ to 10 ' then 3 " increments
