

## Liberty-Benton Invitational Track Meet

Saturday, April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2018

1. Entries are due by 3pm on Friday 4/27. Scratches and replacements after that must be communicated to me as soon as you arrive Saturday morning. Please try to limit these to emergencies.
2. Coach's packets may be picked up Saturday morning upon arrival at the ticket booth.
3. Ohio High School Athletic Association Track and Field rules will govern this meet.
4. Starting blocks will not be furnished and we ask that athletes wear 1/8" spikes. **No chalk is permitted to be used as marks** on any all-weather surface. All coaches are reminded to bring batons for relays.
5. All entries and results will be done using Baumspage. If you have emergency replacements on the day of the meet please find Nate Irwin when you arrive to make any changes. Please limit these last minute replacements to emergencies. Scratches can happen at any time.
6. Scoring will be on a 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 basis.
7. Plaques will be awarded for the first 3 places in each event and ribbons for places 4-8. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams and combined boys and girls score will receive trophies. A plaque will be awarded to the Outstanding Male and Female performer.
8. Starting heights will be decided after checking the entries for the high jump and pole vault.
9. The admission charge will be \$6 for Adults and \$4 for Students. Coaches that arrive when the team arrives will be admitted for free.
10. Each contestant is responsible for reporting on time for their events. When first call is made for the event, competitors should report to the clerk in the bullpen. (Southwest corner of the track)
11. Spikes will not be permitted in the stadium seating area or restrooms. Please share this with your team.
12. Food will be sold in the concession stand throughout the day.
13. 2018 LB Invitational T-Shirts will available to buy.
