**SCORING:** 10 - 8 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1 (eight score/top eight earn awards)

ADMISSION: \$6.00 Adults and Students

LANE ASSIGNMENTS: Heats will be set up based on the times submitted to baumspage.com. All coaches are on their honor as to player participation limits and eligibility. All participants must be on your current OHSAA eligibility list.

STARTING BLOCKS: Will be furnished by Mapleton High School

ENTRY FEE: \$125 - EACH for Boys & Girls Teams (\$250 Total)

EVENTS: 3:30 p.m.	(18 Events – Boys) (18 Events – Girls) First call for field events & Coaches Meeting at Pavillion (please sign coaches verification & pole vault forms at this time)

\*Senior Recognition - We will pause the meet for approximately 15 min. for our senior recognition after the mile.

\*We will have a Throwers 4x100 relay for boys and girls after the 4x400. This event will not be scored into meet results but will have medals for the top team.

#### 1. Note! We will make 1st call promptly at 3:30 and try to start events as quickly as athletes are ready.

2. Drop scratches for all events will take place at the event. <u>No substitutions allowed</u>, as the entry deadline on Baumspage has been extended to 10:00 am on Friday, April 28, 2023.

3. Shot – Discus – Long Jump: Three Trials with top 9 to finals. We will be running flights for these three events. Each throw will require a minimum distance effort for recording. For the discus, the minimum is 100 feet for the boys and 80 feet for the girls. For the shot, the minimum is 30 feet for the boys and 20 feet for the girls. Long Jump will start with the girls 1st. Pole vault boys first (Opening Height to be determined after entries). Boys shot first, Girls discus first.

4. High Jump: Girls on Green Mat, (Opening at 4'0")—Boys on Blue Mat, (Opening at 5'0")

### 5. Relays:

- A. 3200M Relay 2 turn stagger California Exchange.
- B. 400M Relay lanes the entire race, yellow to yellow exchange.
- C. 1600M Relay 3 turn stagger, California Exchange the second, third, and fourth.
- D. 800M Relay lanes the entire race, red to red first and second exchange, yellow to yellow third exchange.

6. All participants NOT involved in an event <u>MUST</u> be on the outside of the track or in the stands. Athletes warming up for an event may utilize unused parts of the track or areas outside the track. *NO athletes are permitted to warm-up on the infield. We ask that Coaches remain OUTSIDE the fence* with athletes unless called to the finish line or are at Long Jump. We will strive to keep the track and infield clear of unnecessary traffic. We will direct finishers to exit the gate on the West end of the track immediately after the race.

- 7. PLEASE TELL ATHLETES NOT TO WEAR SPIKES IN THE BLEACHERS. Camps may be set up with the understanding of proper social distancing from other camps/competitors.
- 8. All contestants must report to the clerk of course at the east end of the track (under scoreboard) on the second call or be scratched. (200M Dash and 300 hurdles are to check in and then report to the start of the event.) If a competitor in a field event is called to run, they must tell the event judge that they are leaving to run and should return efficiently.
- 9. All contestants are to remain in their lanes (on the track in distance races) at the completion of the race until they are asked to leave by the head judge/FAT operator.
- 10. The clerk in the bullpen will check spikes.  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch spikes or smaller.
- 11. Reminder, please make sure your entry fee of \$250 total has been sent in.
- 12. After teams are dropped at the track, please have the bus drivers' park in the elementary lot. <u>We dismiss school</u> <u>at 3:00.</u>

## To register online:

## 2. If you have an account:

- a) Click on Login and enter your UserID/e-mail address and Password!
- b) If you forget your UserID or Password, click the Help link and select the appropriate solution.
- 3. If you do not have an account:
  - a) Click Apply and submit an Application.
  - b) Use a valid e-mail address and any password that you can remember!
- 4. Submit an "intended" roster early! Return later to make corrections and final changes. a) Use Add/Modify Athletes to enter your athlete's names, grades, and competitor number (OHSAA high schools only) into the database. \*The list will be alphabetized automatically. i) Enter your complete roster. Include anyone who could conceivably compete! ii) Use Submit Event Rosters to enter athletes, relays, and marks.

a) To enter individual events: Select the athlete from the list and enter a mark. b)

**To enter a relay:** Enter a mark and select the 4 anticipated relay team members. (1) List in expected order. Changes may be made before the team competes!

b) Always click Save/Submit and Print Rosters when you finish to submit the roster! i) Click the Printable Roster and Confirmation Form to print a copy for your records. ii) What you see on the Confirmation Form is what will be submitted for the meet! c) Return any time before deadline to make changes!

d) The **Online Scratch/Substitution Form** will not be accessible. Note the entry deadline above.
