Admissions: All spectators will be charged \$7.00. MAC passes will be accepted

Concessions: Concessions will be available throughout the entire meet.

Bus Parking: All buses will park at the swimming pool after they drop off the athletes. [Click here](#) for directions

Substitutions: There will be no scratch/substitution window available online. Scratches can be made upon arrival. **The only substitutions allowed will be due to illness or injury. Remember that any athlete replaced due to illness or injury will be eliminated from competition for the remainder of the meet. In the event of an injury or illness substitutions may be made. Simply fill out a replacement form that can be picked up in the press box and have your athlete deliver the form to the clerk.**

Team Camps: Camps are to be set up under the bleachers on the south side of the stadium, or in the grass area immediately east of those bleachers.

Implements: You may use your own implements, provided they are “checked in” and determined to be of legal weight. Weigh-in will be at the north side of the concession stand. Your implements must be made available for all competitors to use. In section 3 (article 1 & 2) the discus is discussed and in section 4 (articles 1 & 2) the shot is discussed.

TRACK INFIELD: Open only to active competitors in events located in the infield area. Coaches, fans, and other athletes are permitted only on the outside perimeter of the track. The only exceptions to the “infield rule” will be for emergencies or for pole vault and high jump coaches where there will be designated coaching areas on the north and east sides of the

landing areas respectively. Coaches: Please remind your athletes to stay out of the infield unless they are actively competing in an event requiring them to be there in that location.

300M Hurdles and 200M Dash runners report to the clerk at their respective starting lines.
All other runners report to the clerk at the NORTHWEST corner of the track.

All running events will be run as a final.

Results will be posted on the north side of the concession stand immediately after they are announced.

SCORING: Top "8" places: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1

AWARDS: Ribbons will be given for the 2nd - 8th places. Team plaques will be given to the 1st and 2nd place teams. Awards will be available shortly after the presentation of team awards in the upper field house. Individual 1st placers will receive their awards at the All-MAC Banquet
