- Entries:** The baumspage window closes at **11:00 AM, Thursday, May 9**. Lane assignments, starting heights, etc., will be posted on baumspage Thursday evening. ***Past the deadline, there can be no additions, only scratches or drop/adds.***
- Scratches:** We will accept changes until 10:00 AM on Saturday. Please email changes to my email address above. Once the meet begins, we will accept drops; but no drop/adds will be allowed, except in case of injury. If an athlete drops because of injury, he is ineligible for any following events. Any changes during the meet must be made at the press box, not at the event or at check-in.
- Scoring:** We will score 8 places in all events: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1
- Workers:** Each school will supply workers to help with a field event (as shown on the schedule page). NO backup timers will be needed. **Please provide these names no later than Monday, May 6. Instead of emailing, there is a form in the shared Google folder for you to use.**
- Facilities:** Please use 1/8 or 1/4 inch spikes. Tape is acceptable for marking the jumps, and tennis balls or the like (you supply) should be used for relays. Please supply your own batons.
- Implements:** Please weigh in your implements. Location will be announced.
- Sprints:** As of now, there will be NO semis this year. All races less than 800M will instead be run as finals in two heats, with the slower heat running first. PLEASE be honest with your entries. Remember though, that anyone can score from either heat.
- Concession:** We will have our concession stand open.
- Awards:** There will be a team trophy for champion. There will be individual and relay medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place
- AOTY:** ***For NBC Athlete of the Year, each coach may nominate one of his athletes. These nominations should be added to the shared google form that you should have already received. You will then get the ballot sent back to you, which you will then bring to the meet on Saturday. Coaches are not allowed to vote for their own athletes.***
- AOTM:** There will be both a track and a field athlete of the meet voted on that day as well. Girls' coaches vote for girls, boys' coaches likewise for boys. The vote for these awards will be by the 50 yard line after the 4 X 400 M relay.
- Coaches:** There will be a short coaches' meeting at 9:15 in the hospitality tent.

Competition will be open pit for one hour, then finals
Maumee will supply 4 workers for boys and **Genoa** will supply 4 workers for girls
- Boys Shot put, girls to follow
There will be 3 attempts, then the top 9 throwers go to finals for 3 more attempts
Otsego will supply 3 workers for boys and **Fostoria** will supply 3 workers for girls
- Girls Discus, boys to follow
There will be 3 attempts, then the top 9 throwers go to finals for 3 more attempts
Oak Harbor will supply 3 workers for boys and **Rossford** will supply 3 workers for girls

Note: In the SP and DT, athletes will be seeded from worst to best, with the top 9 going to finals. In the PV and HJ, they will be seeded from worst to best. LJ is open pit, so there will be no seeding. There will, however, be finals.
