FACILITIES: All-weather track (1/4" spikes), no "Christmas Tree" spikes! Concrete shot and discus rings.

ENTRIES: All entries via [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com). **Registration entry window closes on FRIDAY**

**March 31st, 2023 @ 11am.** Lane assignments will be handed out on the day of the event. Any last minute scratches can be done in the press box until 3:15 pm. ***We will not reseed any events due to roster last-minute scratch/replacements. Changed athletes will simply replace the original***

*athlete's or relay's lane/heat/flight.*

Field events are two-person teams. One relay team per event. The field events are the same as dual meets with the addition of the triple jump.

\*The open races are: 100m dash, 100 & 110 Hurdles, and 1600m run. These will have one entrant from each team.\*

SCORING: This is based on the number of teams entered for the entire meet not based on individual events.

7 + Teams =	Running Events = 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1,	Relays 10 - 8 - 6 - 5- 4- 2- 1

WEIGH-INS: Weigh-ins will take place @ 3pm (if Friday), 8:30am on Saturday. All common implements.

MANAGER: The meet manager is Shane Burrows. Take all questions to him first at [sburrows@perkinsschools.org](mailto:sburrows@perkinsschools.org) , or to the Finish Line, on the competition day. The jury, if needed, will be one coach from each school . Please Note: The jury will function in an advisory capacity only, Head Officials are the only ones that can change marked / timed results.

MARKINGS: Please make marks for all for exchange zones, field events, and relay events with tennis balls.

**Please, NO tape will be permitted on any track surface.**

**High Jump will be allowed to use a small chalk mark.**

RESULTS: The results and awards will be available in the press box approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the 4 x 400 m relay. Results will *not* be printed out, but will be posted to Baumspage as soon as possible on the night of the event in .pdf and .html format.

RACE TIMES: The schedule will roll after the 4 x 1600 (6400m relays) that are printed on the time schedule will be followed as promptly as possible. They have been taken from the previous year's times.

BULL-PEN: For all running events, athletes should report to the clerk at the bull pen area. Runners will be sent to the exchange zones directly from the bullpen. Relay replacement runners should be handled at the bullpen or before the meet in the press box.

**The gates at the finish line and in front of 100 start will be closed and not available until the**

end of the meet. Athletes and coaches should use the Bull-pen gate or the two gates on the Visitors side of the stadium to enter and exit the track.

NO eating, drinking, or spikes on the synthetic field surface. Athletes should warm up on the back stretch of the track.

There should be no coaches or athletes by the finish line. Athletes must remain in the “D” areas - Long jump and pole vault area, or in the stands, not on the football field.

### GIRLS FIELD EVENTS -

**LONG JUMP** - Both girls and boys, using 2 different runways/pits. \*Four jumps total per athlete.

### **TRIPLE JUMP - AFTER LONG JUMP**

**HIGH JUMP** - Girls first, Starting height - TBD by entries - then up 2”

\* In the high jump, instruct your athletes that they MUST be excused by the judge when checking out. We will jump out of order if necessary, but the bar will not be lowered, nor will the official accept needless delays - Check-out at 2nd call ONLY!!

**SHOT PUT** - After boys. Four “throws” per athlete

Flight # 2 - Bellevue, Genoa, Perrysburg, Perkins

**DISCUS** - Four throws per athlete.

**POLE VAULT** - Girls start after boys. Starting height is TBD by entries, then up 6” until completed.

**BOYS FIELD EVENTS -**

**LONG JUMP** – We will run two pits. Four jump attempts for each jumper.

**TRIPLE JUMP - AFTER LONG JUMP- four attempts / jumper**

**HIGH JUMP** - Starts after Girls. Starting height- **TBD by entries** - then up 2” thereafter

\* In the high jump, instruct your athletes that they MUST be excused by the official.

**SHOT PUT** - Four Throws per person

AWARDS/RESULTS - 5 to 10 minutes after the boys 4 x 400 relay. Results will be posted on Baumspage and sent to the Sandusky Register following the meet.

Listen to the PA for the first call of each event, then report to the bull-pen area located at the scoreboard end of the stadium. **All Hip #'s go on the RIGHT HIP.**

## **BREAKING TIES IN FIELD EVENTS**

Tie Breaking:

Long Jump - Triple Jump - Shot - Discus

1. Longest effort
2. 2nd longest effort
3. 3rd longest effort, etc.

High Jump - Pole Vault

1. Highest jump made
2. Total misses of jumpers
3. Jump off: 1 per school - 1 attempt at last height missed  
-Up (1" H.J. - 3" P.V) if both make; Down 1"  
if both miss, until there is a winner.  
-Only one attempt each at each height.

\*\* There shall be **NO TIES** in the field events for 1st Place - 3rd places!

\*\* Any heights made in a jump-off shall not count towards the total team height or record.

NOTES:

There will be 5 minutes of run-throughs or practice throws between flights!

You have 1 minute to throw or jump when called "up" by the judge!

REMEMBER - There is a TEAM trophy for the highest team point total in the field events.
