## **SCOL Track & Field Championships**

<u>Schools</u>: Chillicothe, Clinton Massie, East Clinton, Hillsboro, McClain, Miami Trace, Washington CH, Wilmington

<u>Time Schedule</u>: See schedule below. The time schedule will be a rolling schedule. It is the athlete's responsibility to report to the event on time.

<u>Uniform Numbers</u>: All athletes must wear the uniform number assigned to them on both days of competition. It is the participant and coaches' responsibility to ensure compliance. All athletes must wear a school issued uniform. It is imperative that each athlete compete in their assigned number.

<u>League Substitution Forms</u>: In the first level of competition a maximum of two eligible athletes may be named on the entry form for each event other than relays.

#### Relay Teams:

- a. members of a relay team (4,5,or 6) must be designated prior to competing for the first time,
- b. all members of a relay team must be eligible by the standards and bylaws set forth by the OHSAA,
- c. coaches will be provided a relay check-in card for each relay team entered 4x100 (yellow), 4x200 (black), 4x400 (blue), and 4x800 (green),
- d. the relay team officially becomes an entry when the relay check-in card is handed to the clerk. Once the team is officially entered, there may be no additions, deletions, or changes to the card.
- e. the clerk will check off the four names of the runners who will compete,
- f. members of a relay team may be changed from the district to the regional meet, provided all other eligibility requirements have been met.

**Tournament Entry**: Individual entries for the league must be entered on www.baumspage.com. Entries must be submitted by Monday, May 8, 2017 at 9:00 p.m. Baumspage will not permit a coach to submit entries without all athletes on the roster having an assigned jersey number.

Scratches and substitutions will be done at the same web address. Changes must be submitted by 2 PM on the first day of competition. Day 2 all changes must be made by Thursday at 2 PM. After that time both days it will only be a scratch for the event unless it is an injury.

**Sample substitution**: Scratch John Smith/ Add Jon Doe. Make sure that you specify the full name of whom you are scratching and the full name of whom you are adding. If these items are not completed in correct fashion, your substitutions will NOT be processed.

The heat/lane/flight assignments will be posted on baumspage Monday evening. This information will not include scratches after the submission deadline and heats may be changed/condensed if scratches merit a fewer number of heats.

Packets for Coaches: Pick up your packets in the Press Box from 3:30pm to 5:00p.m. the first day of competition. Your packets will include: heat/lane/flight assignments, relay check-in cards, pole vault verification form.

**Restricted Areas**: Only Coaches or Competing Athletes may be allowed in the roped off coaching areas and the infield of the track, those areas are off limits to spectators and non-competing athletes.

Athlete Check-in Area: The check-in will be in the bullpen area located next to the concession stand North end of the track.

**Starting Blocks**: We have 8 sets of regular international starting blocks. Please feel free to bring your own set of blocks. The spikes in the blocks are to be 1/4 inch pyramid spikes.

**Gates**: Spectator gates will open one hour prior to competition. There is one gate toward the North end of the track.

**Team Camp Site**: Tents may be set-up on the outside perimeter of the track that does NOT interfere with spectator viewing. We ask that no athletes sit in the spectator areas/bleachers.

Jumps/Relay/Vaulting Checkmarks: Please use tennis balls. Chalk should not be used.

**High Jump & Pole Vault Pits**: Please remind your athletes to stay off of these, they are restricted for competition only.

Coaching Areas: All coaches must remain out of the timing and judging areas. The infield area (end zone to end zone) will be prohibited. Coaches will not be permitted to stand or sit in the

prohibited areas. Coaches are permitted to confer with their long jump, high jump, and pole vault athletes in the designated areas. Coaches are permitted to videotape.

**Admission**: Admission for all fans and spectators is \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students. All results will be viewable on www.baumspage.com. Each team may have no more than two statisticians. Statisticians are not permitted in the press box to keep their books. The press box is restricted to officials and meet workers.

**Videotaping**: All videotaping should be done from the designated spectator and/or coaching areas and shall not impede the view of others.

**Bus Parking**: Please plan to arrive no earlier than 3 PM to allow school traffic to clear for the day. Busses should park at the far end of the parking lot nearest Route 62. Busses should not park in the parking lot across from the track & field complex.

**Team Clean-Up**: We ask that you and your team be respectful of your team area and please clean up your trash before leaving, there is a trash bag in each team packet for your convenience.

Timing: Fully Automated Timing (FAT) will be provided for this meet.

**Spikes**: 1/4" cone/pyramid maximum only. No needle or pins allowed. Please ensure compliance with your athletes.

I further certify that all student-athletes and other team personnel have been advised of their responsibilities relative to good sporting conduct during this competition. In addition, I understand and accept responsibility for adhering to the OHSAA participation limitation of four events per individual athlete per tournament contest.
