7:00 AM Sign-in at computer and confirm roster.

8:00 AM Weigh-in at Elder High School

- A. All wrestlers shall be present and remain in the designated weigh-in area.
- B. OHSAA Skin Authorization Forms properly dated must be presented at check-in.
- C. The weigh-in shall proceed through weight classes beginning at 106 lbs. and end immediately upon completion of the 285 lbs. class. A contestant may step on and off the first scale two times. If he fails to make weight on the first scale, he shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight.

Concessions: Available both days with a wide variety. Please advise parents and fans that no crockpots, toasters, microwaves, or electrical appliances of any kind may be bought into the facility. There will be no glass containers in any of the facilities and absolutely NO FOOD, coolers, or bags in the wrestling area!

Locker space: Locker Rooms will be available. Please be sure to secure all valuables.

<u>Seeding:</u> Seeding will be by criteria! Please read the seeding criteria carefully. **The online entry form must be submitted before 7:00 PM on Wednesday, January 11, 2012.** Please use the Online Form at **www.baumspage.com!** Remember that you may change your roster at the meeting on Friday.

<u>Prior to the seed meeting:</u> If you are certain before Friday that a nominated wrestler is changing weight class, please notify Gary Baumgartner. If you know on Friday that you may be late to the seed meeting, please call Gary's cell phone at **513-594-6154** or Kurt Ruffing at **513-325-1380** so the criteria can be applied to the proper weight class.

<u>After the seed meeting:</u> If a wrestler selected as a seed in one weight class moves to another class, he will be drawn randomly into the bracket for that weight class. The alternate will take his place in the original class.

Seeding and Entry Information

Seeding Information and Criteria:

- A. We will seed the top eight wrestlers in each class and select one alternate.
- B. Seeding will be based on the following criteria:
 - 1. State Champion
 - 2. State Place in order of place.
 - 3. Catholic Invitational Champion.
 - 4. District Place in order of place (*Must be State Qualifier)
 - 5. Catholic Invitational Place in order of place.
 - 6. Current overall record. (8-match minimum must have winning percentage.)
- C. Seeds will be determined in order from first to eighth by applying the above criteria.
 - 1. If criteria #1 to #5 are equal, priority will be given to the wrestler returning in the same or lower weight class.
 - 2. Ties for winning percentage will be broken by head to head competition, then random draw between wrestlers involved.
 - 3. Wrestlers that qualify for seeds #1 to #6 must accept the seed. Those that qualify for #7, #8, or the alternate may "pass" on the seed!

Re-draw Procedure on tournament day:

- A. Once brackets are drawn and printed, there will be no re-draws. However in order to maintain the integrity of the brackets as printed and to be fair to the contestants, the following procedure will be used:
 - 1. Seeded wrestlers will be rotated up to their appropriate line, and the replacement from their team placed on the line of the alternate.
 - 2. Non-seeded wrestlers lines on the bracket will become byes if a bye is legal.
 - 3. If a bye is not permitted, a coin flip (or series of flips) will determine which line will become a bye, and which wrestler must be moved to make the bracket legal.
 - 4. The over-all goal will be to maintain the integrity of the bracket in the simplest and fairest way possible.

Procedure for Online Rosters and Seed Nominations:

- A. Use **the Online Roster and Seed Form** at **www.baumspage.com** to submit rosters and seed nominations before **7:00 PM, Wednesday, January 11, 2012.**
- B. All accounts from last year were retained, but the associations with schools and teams were cleared. If you had an account, use that e-mail address/password. If no account, use Apply
- C. If you have problems click the **Contact Us** and submit a help request! **For immediate help,** call **Gary Baumgartner at 513-594-6154** or **Terry Young at 740-517-0195**!
 - 2. Submit an "intended" roster early! Return anytime before deadline to make changes! Use My Sports | Select Teams to claim your team.

Use My Sports | Wrestling | Modify Athletes to enter your athlete's names and grades.

- Enter them one at a time or paste the complete roster from an Excel file with three fields: first name, last name, and grade.
- 3. Use My Sports | Wrestling | Submit Rosters to access the entry template.
- 4. Click **Submit Rosters** to submit and **Get Printable Roster** to print a copy for your records.
- E. Please note: The online entry window will close precisely at the published deadline!
- F. To nominate for a seed, fill-in the appropriate tournament information, and record.
 - 1. Indicate both the place and weight class that the wrestler competed in last year.
 - 2. District place must be State qualifier. (Top 4 at District.)
 - 3. Current record (Must be winning record with 8-match minimum!)
- G. There will be no additional seed nominations after Wednesday, January 11, 2012.
