Entries	Coaches do not need to submit entries. Qualifiers will automatically transfer from the sectional sites.

Bus Drop Off	Bus drivers should drop off at the lower entrance and park in the designated area. A parking attendant will greet your bus and provide directions.
Team Check-in	Coaches should report to the table that corresponds to their sectional site to retrieve team packet.
Weight Check	Scales will be available in the wrestling room to check weight up until 5 minutes before the start of weigh-ins.
Coaches Meeting	Mandatory coaches meeting will be held in the auditorium on Friday at 3:15 PM. Only one coach per team will be permitted to attend the meeting.
Weigh-Ins & Skin Checks Day 1	Skin checks and weigh-ins will begin at 2:00 PM. Any special equipment or skin authorization forms should be presented at weigh-ins. When reporting to weigh-ins, wrestlers should be wearing their singlet and ready to step on the scale. Weight allowance for Friday is Scratch +2 and weight allowance for Saturday is Scratch +3 Two certified scales will be available.
Weigh-outs	Weigh-outs for day two will begin after each wrestlers' last match on Friday in the wrestling/weigh-in room. Scales will be open/available throughout the day Friday for wrestlers to check weight. Weigh-outs will conclude 30 minutes after their last match on Friday. Wrestlers who do not weigh-out on Friday may do so on Saturday at 9:00 am.
Skin Check - Second Day	Mandatory second day skin checks will be at 9:00 AM Saturday.
Admission	Tickets can be purchased online at https://www.ohsaa.org/tickets or cash at the gate. \$8.00 per day for adults and \$5.00 per day for students.
Alternates	Alternates may enter the facility in order to be available to weigh-in should a line open on the bracket PLEASE inform Terry Young immediately if you become aware of any qualifier who will be unable to compete at the district tournament.

Concessions	Concessions will be available.
Team Food	No coolers, crockpots or other electrical food devices will be permitted to be brought into the facility.
Hospitality	Hospitality will be provided to coaches.

Locker Rooms	Limited locker room space will be available.
Officials	Assigned by the OHSAA Southeast and East District Athletic Boards.
Athletic Trainer	Two certified athletic trainers will be available during the event. Any athlete who needs taped prior to competition must provide proper documentation and own supplies.
Physician	A physician will be on site during all weigh-in and skin check times to evaluate any skin related issues.
Weather Contingency	Should there be inclement weather or some other emergency that prohibits the tournament from being contested as scheduled, Sunday, March 3 is the make-up date with corresponding start times.
Professionalism of Coaches	It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. *Personal grooming and appropriate dress is standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District or State Wrestling Tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited.* Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The Rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.
