IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. Please arrive at Steubenville High School by 7:30 AM.
- 2. You should plan on dropping off and entering the school on either Logan Street (north side of school) or Dock Street (south side of school).
- 3. Weigh-ins will begin at 8:00 in the high school gym (you will be given directions upon arrival). You may check your weight until 7:45.
- 4. Coaches seeding meeting will take place in the Keenan Conference Room 15 minutes after weigh-ins begin (approximately 8:15 AM).
- 5. Reminder: Wrestlers can wrestle up to 6 matches if needed.
- 6. Doors to the gym will open at 9:15 for all spectators.
- 7. Wrestling will begin at 10:00 with preliminary and quarter-final action on 3 mats. It will be followed by consolation and semi-final matches.
- 8. At the conclusion of all consolation and semi-final matches, we will take a short break to prepare for First, Third and Fifth place matches
- Tickets can be purchased online through Hometown Ticketing using the following site (<u>www.ohsaa.org/tickets</u>) - Tickets may also be purchased at the Gate. – Adults \$8.00, Students \$5.00.
- 10. All entries and seeding criteria must be submitted via baumspage.com before 7:00 PM, Thursday, February 22, 2024. Schools will be subject to a \$150 fine for wrestlers entered after the deadline.

<u>Professionalism of Coaches</u> It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District or State Wrestling Tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The Rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.
